#### Working Holiday visas

Australia currently has working holiday arrangements with the following EU countries: [Belgium](#), [Cyprus](#), [Denmark](#), [Estonia](#), [Finland](#), [France](#), [Germany](#), [Ireland](#), [Italy](#), [Malta](#), the [Netherlands](#), [Sweden](#) and the [United Kingdom](#).

*The working holiday visa scheme is a bilateral arrangement between Australia and the individual Member State of the EU, there is no working holiday visa for "Europe".*
