The objective of this tender is to conclude a framework contract with a company specialised in the security of persons and goods. The scope of the services includes, but is not limited to: (1) the surveillance and patrolling of the premises (office building, Residence of the Ambassador and Expats accommodations) of the Delegation to avoid intrusion and attack on persons and their belongings; (2) the control of access to the premises by visitors; (3) the communication between the premises by means of a VHF/UHF radio network linking all the premises to a central operations centre to be manned by operators from the company; (4) the immediate intervention by use of a rapid response or back-up unit to any of the premises in the event of an incident; (5) other related security services such as installation of alarm systems. A framework contract with a maximum duration of 4 years will be implemented via specific contracts and/or order forms.

(b) they or the persons having powers of representation, decision making or control over them have been convicted of an offence concerning their professional conduct by a judgment of a competent authority of a Member State which has the force of 'res judicata';

Member State which has the force of 'res judicata'; (c) they have been guilty of grave professional misconduct proven by any means which the contracting authority can justify including by decisions of the EIB and international organisations; (d) they are not in compliance with their obligations relating to the payment of social security contributions or the payment of taxes in accordance with the legal provisions of the country in which they are established or with those of the country of the contracting authority or those of the country where the contract is to be performed; (e) they or the persons having powers of representation, decision making or control over them have been the subject of a judgment which has the force of 'res judicata' for fraud, corruption, involvement in a criminal organisation, money laundering or any other illegal activity where such illegal activity is detrimental to the Union's financial interests: Union's financial interests:

(f) they are subject to an administrative penalty referred to in Article 109(1).
