

Additional Information Session on the European Instrument for Democracy and Human Rights, Friday 19 September, 08:30 hrs, European Union Delegation to Botswana and SADC, Robinson Road, Plot 758, Gaborone.

The Delegation of the European Union to Botswana and SADC invites civil society organisations (including non-governmental non-profit organisations, independent foundations, community based organisations and private sector non-profit agencies) to submit proposals for funding for human rights and democracy activities in Botswana. The activities are to be funded by the European Instrument for Human rights (EIDHR).

The main focus areas are: Provision of nation-wide human rights/civic education; supporting the rights of the child and strengthening child protection mechanisms at all levels; Advocacy and promotion of broad and inclusive political and social dialogue.
