

"CLIMATE CHANGE, WE ARE ALL RESPONSIBLE"

30 October - 6 November 2015, Planetario de Rio de Janeiro

"Climate Change, We are All Responsible" is an event organised by the Delegation of the European Union in Brazil, WWF-Brazil and the Fundação Planetaría of Rio de Janeiro in partnership with Prefeitura do Rio de Janeiro, the Brazilian Ministry of Environment, the European Union Member States in Brazil and their cultural institutions.

The world today lives an environmental challenge to lower greenhouse gases emissions in a context of population growth requiring higher energy consumption. This is an essential stage for the survival of the planet. The year 2015 is key to take decisions and change habits for a low carbon future in the world. In this context, the objectives of the event are:

- To raise awareness on the reality of Climate Change and the importance of acting as individual citizens, community, civil society, public administration, industry, artistic community and to adopt solutions that contribute to address all the aspects related to climate change.
- To engage and expose the general public and specific stakeholders to replicable and successful Brazilian and European Union policies, initiatives and good practices that contribute to contain, mitigate, or adapt to Climate Change.

The "Climate Change, We are All Responsible" event will focus on 6 key themes:

- 1) Water
- 2) Energy
- 3) Solid Waste
- 4) Use of land and Agriculture
- 5) Urbanism and Urban Mobility
- 6) Security and Climate Change

The event will include a technical conference for experts from Brazil and the European Union, and free activities from 30 October to 6 November 2015 that will be completely free and open to the public, with informative, cultural, recreational and interactive exhibits about the impacts of climate change, the solutions and opportunities.
