

ANNUAL WORK PROGRAMME FOR GRANTS

DELEGATION OF THE EUROPEAN UNION TO CAMBODIA

The EU-Cambodia Co-operation Facility for Governance and Human Rights (ECCF)

1. Basic act and Financing source

Regulation (EC) No 1905/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 on establishing a financing instrument for development cooperation.

This action will be financed by budget line 19 10 01 01.

2. Objectives of the programme, priorities of the year 2011 and expected results

The overall objective of the ECCF is to contribute to poverty reduction, foster reconciliation and improve equity of vulnerable groups by supporting initiatives in the field of governance, judicial reform and human rights, including activities identified as a result of meetings of the "EC-Cambodia Sub-group on Co-operation in Institution Building, Administrative Reform, Governance and Human Rights".

The call for proposal from civil society organisations will consist of two separate lots for:

- Actions in support of the government's "Strategy for Legal and Judicial Reform".
- Actions in support of the "National Programme for the Sub-national Democratic Development 2010-2018".

3. Eligibility conditions

The details will be specified in the Guidelines for Grant Applicants.

4. Selection and award criteria

The evaluation will be carried out in accordance with the procedures set out in the Practical Guide to contract procedures for EU external actions.

5. Maximum rate of European Union financing

The maximum rate of EU co-financing to the total eligible cost of the action shall not exceed 80 % of the total eligible costs of the action.

6. Schedule of calls for proposals

The call is tentatively scheduled to be launched in April 2011.

7. Indicative amount of calls for proposals

The overall indicative amount made available under the call for proposals is EUR 3 000 000.
