Thorbjørn Jagland: Ukraine has a lot on its plate, and Europe is here to help 16/03/2015 - Kyiv Post

The European Court of Human Rights has ordered Russia to give explanations to Ukraine's claim against Crimea's annexation by March 25, Minister of Justice Pavlo Petrenko said at a news briefing. "Ukraine's application to the European Court of Human Rights is being processed, and Russia shall provide its explanation by late March. Of course, it will try to drag out the term," the minister noted.

The government's human rights watchdog has attacked Conservative party proposals to repeal the Human Rights Act and withdraw from the European Court of Human Rights in Strasbourg.
