Founded in 1875, is the most widely circulating Egyptian [daily](#) newspaper, and the second oldest after al-Waqa'i`al-Masriya (English: The Egyptian Events, founded 1828). It is majority owned by the [Egyptian government](#).

❖ **Al-Akhbar: Egyptian state-owned semi-official daily newspaper**

It was founded in May [1952](#) as a part of [Akhbar El Yom](#).

❖ **Al-Gomhoria: Egyptian state-owned daily newspaper**

An influential state-owned [Egyptian Arabic language](#) daily [newspaper](#). It was established in 1954.

❖ **Al-Shorouk: Egyptian daily independent newspaper**

is a prominent Arabic newspaper published in Egypt^[1] and several other Arabic nations. It is a daily independent newspaper, covering mainly politics, militant affairs and sport.

❖ **Al-Masry al-Yom: Independent daily newspaper**

On 7 June 2004, it published its first edition. The paper initially circulated primarily amongst Cairo's intellectual elite, providing objective news coverage in the belief that good news would beat sensationalist reporting found in other Egyptian print media. After 3 years, it was challenging *Al-Ahram* for the status of being the national paper of record. Though

Elections Updates(1/5)

Contestations against NDP remnants delayed until Supreme Administrative Court pronounces its decision. NDP remnants protest in front of Mansora Administrative Court, refusing the Court's decision on the grounds that the Court's head is an MB member.

290 contestations in all governorates against NDP remnants.

HEC approves The Eye symbol for the Egyptian Bloc Coalition.

Wafd accuses MB of buying votes by distributing meat.

Freedom and Justice gives out candy children as a kind of publicity.

Military factories built 30 thousand booths for voters.



Elections Updates(2/5)

MB considered rejection by HEC over accusations of using religious mottos contradictory with the Administrative Court decision of 2007, stating that their motto did not violate constitutional principles.

Several parties highlighted the economic part in their platform, promising to solve current economic issues, in order to win votes



Elections Updates(3/5)

HEC said it hasn't received administrative court decision yet.

HEC issued a guide that provides voters with all the information they need on the voting process.

Vice President of State Council said that the Administrative Court's decision was final unless the Court of Cassation rejects it.



Elections Updates(4/5)

MB held wedding parties for 100 brides and grooms in Sharkeya governorate.

4 candidates withdrew from the elections in Fayoum governorate.

A group of Islamic Movement Youth issued a code of ethics vowing to secure the elections.

No more tribal conflicts in South Sinai after it became one constituency.

Administrative Court is examining a lawsuit against an Egyptian living in Israel married to an Israeli woman to prevent him from voting.

The Libyan National Transitional Council imposed issuance of visas for the entry of Egyptians, Syrians and Algerians into the country.

Tunisia was among the countries exempted from the said visa.



28 Rules Governing TV Coverage of Elections



Among the rules and standards:

- Media personnel, who are running as parliamentary candidates in the elections, are banned from hosting any TV or radio shows.
- Each candidate or party is given 5 minutes on the Radio and 10 minutes on TV to expound on platform.

Religious slogans are barred in electioneering.

The Military Court Uncovers Suspects' Names

General 'Adel al-Mursi, head of the Military Judiciary

declared that civil and military suspects are involved in the ongoing investigations into the Maspero incidents.

The declarations mark the first acknowledgment of the army's

involvement in the incidents.



**Tantawi for President” Campaign Dubs its
Outspoken Critics as Hypocrites**

The popular campaign supporting the nomination of SCAF head, Hussein Tantawi, for presidency condemned some politicians and media persons, who harshly criticized the campaign, as hypocrites.

In a press conference, founder Mahmoud Attiya said those who criticize the campaign aim to drive a wedge between the people and the Army.

Defendant in “Gas Pipeline Blasts” Arrested

Security forces in North Sinai arrested the main suspect behind recent attacks on gas pipelines in the governorate.

Ali Mohamed Hamd, a.k.a El-Tihi, was arrested unscathed on Sunday night. He is the leader of the so-called “Takfir and Jihad in Sinai,” an ideologically-affiliated Qaeda group.

Tihi was also involved in an attack on Al-Arish police station on July 29, which left 2 officers dead and 7 injured.



"Village War" Crawls to Luxor: 2 Injured in Armed Family Feud

A feud between two families took an ugly turn when both sides exchanged fire, leaving two members injured by gunshots.

Security bodies arrested 3 in connection with the armed altercation.

Security bodies are still searching for three missing people in the governorate.



FeAwwa Urges Citizens to Protest on Nov. 18

Presidential hopeful Mohamed Selim El-Awwa called on the masses to partake in the protests of November 18 to reclaim “looted rights.”

Awwa also warned against chanting slogans against the

Supreme Council of the Armed Forces or its leader Field Marshal Hussein Tantawi.

He reiterated rejection of the constitutional principles document

floated by Deputy Prime Minister Ali El-Selmi.



12 Sufi Leaders Get Support of Iranian Shiites against Wahabi Salafists

An Egyptian Sufi delegation, currently visiting Iran, garnered the support of a number of Shiite groups in the country to face the Salafist expansion in Muslim states, especially Egypt.

وفيما أعلنت معظم الأحزاب القضائية بالاعتراضات عن الكفوف النهائية للمرشحين، تأجل الإعلان الرسمي عن الكشوف النهائية للمرة الثانية بسبب عدم انتهاء بعض الجان على مستوى الجمهورية من الفصل في العاوان.

في السياق نفسه، اجتمع المستشار محمد عبدالعزيم الحامدي وزير العدل أمس بعد من أعضاء اللجنة العليا للانتخابات، وقالت مصادر قضائية لـ«المصري اليوم» إن الأعضاء حضرو للانتخابات، ويسري عبدالكريم، رئيس المكتب الفني، وأحمد خافي، رئيس إحدى الجان التوعية، نائب رئيس مجلس الدولة، في حضور المستشار عيم الشريف، مساعد وزير العدل لشؤون التشريع، وناقشوا في اللجنة التشريعية بوزارة العدل تحديد آلية لتصويت المصريين في الخارج بالإضافة إلى إمكانية تنفيذ حكم محكمة

القضاء الإداري بجمع أعضاء الوطني من الترشح للانتخابات البرلمانية المقبلة.

من جانبه، أكد المستشار بسري عبدالكريم، رئيس المكتب الفني باللجنة العليا، أن اللجنة انتهت من تحديد أماكن الـ 61 ألف لجنة قروية، والقضاء

الأعلى منكرو باسماء القضاة الذين زوروا الانتخابات الماضية، وتبع، لا يوجد قاض يعلن على نصفة لا يسلمح للاشراف على الانتخابات، ربه «عبدالكريم، إلى أن اللجنة العليا للانتخابات ليس من مهمتها رصد أي خرق للقواعد البرلمانية سواء من ناحية الشعارات أو القبول، مشيراً إلى أن ما يتم تناوله عن تحقيق اللجنة في تمويل مشروعات تيارات سياسية غير صحيح، وواصل «عبدالكريم»: «رغم هناك بلاغات قدمت ضد البعض، ولكن الهيئة وحدها هي صاحبة حق التحقيق في الجرائم، وأجرباً دعوى جنائية إذا رأت حدية الأهم، وركز أنه لا مخوف من الطرد في القضاء، مشيراً إلى أن تعديلات أحكام القانون رقم ١٢ لسنة ١٩٩٦ لتنظيم مباشرة الحقوق السياسية الصادرة بمرسوم قانون رقم ١١١ لسنة ٢٠١٠ أقرت بأن الجمعيات العمومية هي كل محكمة استئناف أو محكمة ابتدائية تقوم بتحديد دائرة أو أكثر لتلظر في الجرائم الانتخابية والفصل فيها على وجه السرعة، في السياق نفسه، غلقت «المصري اليوم» أن وزارة الخارجية طالبت اللجنة العليا للانتخابات بمحاكمة اللجنة الشرفية على التواطؤ الإلكتروني للجنة. حتى تصيف صلحة بالغة الإيجابية لتسجيل بيانات المصريين في الخارج، وقالت مصادر قضائية إن «الخارجية» يوزر الطلب بأن الجيران تأتي والثالث من أبناء المصريين بالخارج بالجمع لا يوجد العربية،

Head of the Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics said 16 million Egyptians will take part in the first phase

Elections Updates(4/4)

Al-Nour Party launches awareness campaign on Facebook.

140 candidates compete in Imbaba constituency and a heated competition between Salafis and NDP remnants there.

87 candidates compete on 2 seats in the third constituency in Kalyobya governorate.

Al-Jamaa Al-Islamya failed in its ally with MB and didn't get any privilege out of their ally with the Salafis.

Al-Jamaa's slate included the majority of their candidates from Sohag, Asyut, and Menya governorates.

A leader in Al-Jamaa said they are not aiming to win the seats, but rather seeking the political alliance with the Salafis.

Ladies in Matrouh Rebel

A number of women candidates for the Parliament in Matrouh protested against their being in the bottom of the slates.

They threatened to withdraw from the coming elections because being in the bottom of the list meant more expenses for their campaigns.

Six women are running for individual seats in Matrouh Constituency.



Electoral Awareness in Tanta

The 6 of April Movement started a campaign to spread

political awareness amongst people in Tanta, al-Gharbyah governorate.

The campaign is especially meant to spread public

awareness concerning elections.



Farscore who failed NDP Candidates

Farscore in Damietta is the only district that could bring down the NDP candidates for over 32 years.

Now, people in Farscore will most probably vote

for Islamists or members of the Muslim Brotherhood who seem to enjoy wide respect among them.



The Democratic Front Slate Accepted

Asyout Administrative Court ruled in favor of the Democratic Front Party that includes the Revolution Youth Coalition.

According to the ruling, the party's slate is accepted.

The Front Party faced troubles when the General Electoral

Commission of Asyout rejected the slate. Accordingly, the Democratic Front Party filed a claim at the Administrative Court.



Al-Nour Secretary

Secretary of Salafi al-Nour in Asyout, Ayman Shu'ayb refused to permit press conferences with the party's women candidates who wear the niqab (face-covering veils).

Shu'ayb argued that women were on al-Nour slates cosmetically to complete the number of candidates. Women presence on slates is legally mandatory for slates to be accepted.

Salafi women are not allowed to show in the media.



First Claim Against Justice and Freedom's Slate

Port Sa'id's Attorney, Judge Sami 'Adilah called for urgent investigations over "grave violations" committed by Muslim Brotherhood's Freedom and Justice in the governorate.

Wa'il al-Shahhat Muhammad, candidate of the Arab Egyptian Union Party had filed a claim documented with evidence against candidates of the Justice and Freedom Party in the city.

The claim was filed against violations related to using religious slogans. They also used mosques and some schools for their campaign publicities.

The claim demanded to exclude the candidates who committed the violations.



Race Heating up in Isma'ilyyah

The city of Isma'ilyyah is witnessing a heated race.

Electoral conferences and secret meetings are being

held.

The fiercest competition is between two ladies; 'Aydah

al-Kaylani of al-Wa'i Party and Insaf khalil of the Salafi al-Nour

Party.



Remnants in Sohag

16 candidates from the dissolved National

Democratic Party's remnants in Sohag are running in the coming parliamentary elections.

25 former MPs preferred to keep away.



One Lady VS 46 Men in Munouifyyah

In al-Shuhada' Constituency, 46 candidates are competing for individual seats in the Parliament.

Only one lady is running the elections, trying to gain women's confidence in the 700,000- vote district of Birkat Sab' in the city.



Al-Wafd Rejects Secularism and Theocracy

Dr. al-Sayyid al-Badawi, head of al-Wafd Party highlighted the importance of the first phase of the People's Assembly Elections.

Al-Badawi stated that the result of the first phase will determine the party's activity in the next two phases.

Al-Badawi stated also that al-Wafd Party rejects secularism that separates between religion and the state, explaining that, at the same time, the party is against clergy dominance over the State. Al-Badawi elaborated that al-Wafd Party advocated liberalism that abides by the second article of the Egyptian Constitution which states that the Islamic Shari'ah is the main source of legislation.

Al-Badawi added that the Democratic Alliance document signed by all parties admitted Copts' rights to refer to their religious legislations in personal status affairs.



Court Ruling against NDP Remnants in Suez

The Mansoura Administrative Court's decision

excluded 40% of the NDP remnants in Suez from elections.

Government Contests Court Decision to Exclude Former NDP Members from Elections(1/3)

Judge Mohammed Attiya, Minister of Local Development, said the government has already filed an appeal to the decision of the Mansoura Administrative Court to exclude former members of the dissolved National Democratic Party from the coming elections.

“The government should file an appeal to the decision before the Supreme Administrative Court as the decision was based on its previous decision to dissolve the NDP,” he explained.

A meeting between members of the legislative committee at the Cabinet of Ministers, headed by Minister of Justice Mohamed Abd Al-Aziz, concluded that excluding the NDP remnants does not necessarily mean eliminating the entire lists that contained some of the former members of the NDP.



Government Contests Court Decision to Exclude Former NDP Members from Elections(2/3)

NDP remnants responded to the decision by filing lawsuits that demand halting the decision of the Higher Electoral Committee to exclude them from the coming elections. Some of them also filed lawsuits demanding the exclusion of the Muslim Brotherhood members from elections.

In Alexandria, some activists took the initiative to implement “popular exclusion” of NDP remnants, following the Administrative Court’s decision to allow a former member of NDP to run in elections. A number of revolutionary political movements and activists set out in a march to tear down the banners of NDP remnants.

Judges said decisions varied between the Mansoura Court and the Alexandria Court because it is up for each judge to decide whether the exclusion applies to the situation or not.



Government Contests Court Decision to Exclude Former NDP Members from Elections(3/3)

Islamists launch massive campaigns in a number of governorates in Upper Egypt.

Al-Wafd Party accuses Freedom and Justice Party of tearing down their campaign banners in Fayoum.

Final Party Lists Declared (1/2)

Elections Updates (1/2)

Freedom and Justice Party's nominees threatened to protest the decision of the HEC as it refused to hand them the complete data of voters' lists in Cairo. The HEC only gave them partial information whereas it should have given them the complete data of voters as this helps parties during electoral campaigns.

Some of the Sufis, who were former members of the National Democratic Party, challenged the decision of political exclusion. They said it will cause major setbacks in their party lists and they would not have the time to create new ones.
