❖ **Al-Akhbar: Egyptian state-owned semi-official daily newspaper**

It was founded in May [1952](#) as a part of [Akhbar El Yom](#).

❖ **Al-Gomhoria: Egyptian state-owned daily newspaper**

An influential state-owned [Egyptian Arabic language](#) daily [newspaper](#). It was established in 1954.

❖ **Al-Shorouk: Egyptian daily independent newspaper**

is a prominent Arabic newspaper published in Egypt^[1] and several other Arabic nations. It is a daily independent newspaper, covering mainly politics, militant affairs and sport.

❖ **Al-Masry al-Yom: Independent daily newspaper**

On 7 June 2004, it published its first edition. The paper initially circulated primarily amongst Cairo's intellectual elite, providing objective news coverage in the belief that good news would beat sensationalist reporting found in other Egyptian print media. After 3 years, it was challenging *Al-Ahram* for the status of being the national paper of record. Though

Sweif said that the case now is not only about her son but concerns all those held in captivity by the Armed Forces. She called for no more military trials for civilians.

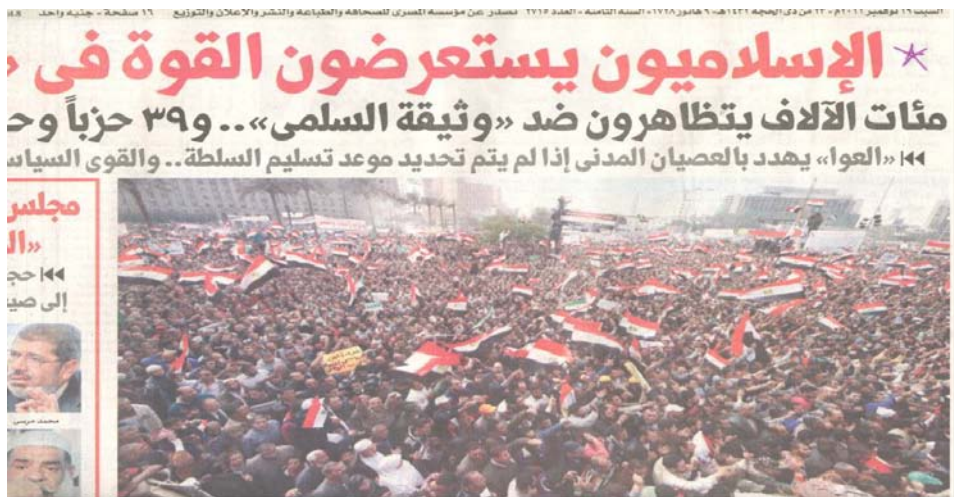

Islamists Demonstrate Power in Tahrir Square Hundreds of Thousands Congregate Against Al Silmy's Document



Hundreds of thousands of protestors gathered today in Tahrir Square to content Al Silmy's document amidst a complete absence of security. Liberal and civil movements have described the Islamist-dominated protests as a "demonstration of power."

The protests also posed as a campaigning opportunity for the Salafi and Islamic movements, while many of the chants took an Islamic turn with protestors demanding the application of Islamic Sharia'.

Committee of Wise Men Ends Agrium Crisis, Damietta Protestors Suspend Rallies



Hundreds of Damietta residents have suspended their protests following ten days of besieging Damietta’s port and intercepting roads leading to Mansoura and Ras Al Ber. Residents were protesting the MOPCO-Agrium’s proposed expansion.

Magdi Al Bassiouni, member of the Committee of Wise Men, said the agreement entailed that expansion is halted in MOPCO’s second and third plants. A committee of thirty individuals who reside close to the plant will be responsible for ensuring that the agreements is complied with.

Mystery Surrounds Election Security Process



الغموض يحيط بتأمين الانتخابات

مصادر: المجلس العسكري أعد خطة لمواجهة الانفلات.. وعناصر مدربة داخل اللجان للتصدي للبلطجية

كتبت- أميرة إبراهيم:

بعد يوم واحد من تأكيد المجلس العسكري أن مسؤولية تأمين العملية الانتخابية لمجلس الشعب والشورى سيكون منوطاً بها بالكامل الداخلية وأجهزتها الأمنية. عادت التقارير المنسوبة إلى مصادر عسكرية تؤكد أن الجيش سيشارك بفاعلية في تأمين الانتخابات بكل مراحلها.

مصادر خاصة مقرية من المجلس العسكري قالت لـالتحرير إن المجلس أعد خطة شاملة لتغطية كل الاحتمالات المطروحة للإخلال بالأمن في أثناء الانتخابات من جهة، وكذا المخططات التي تستهدف استغلال حالة التركيز على تأمين الانتخابات لتنفيذ عمليات غير قانونية أو ذات طابع إجرامي لكنها برزت التحفظ في كشف الخطط بشكل كامل ضماناً لسرية الخطط وفعاليتها.

وأضافت المصادر أن قوات الشرطة والأمن العام ستتولى بشكل رسمي مهام تأمين الناخبين ومقرات اللجان وحفظ الأمن العام في الشوارع والتصدي لمحاولات الخروج على

النظام في أثناء الاقتراع. لكنه أشار إلى أن المجلس العسكري لن يترك المهمة بالكامل للشرطة المدنية حرصاً من المجلس على نجاح جهاز الأمن في استعادة وجوده من خلال تحدي تأمين الانتخابات. وأضاف أن نجاح الشرطة في الاختيار القادم سيمنحها دفعة معنوية ربما تمثل شهادة ميلاد جديدة للدور الذي افتقد بعد انهيار الشرطة مطلع العام الحالي.

من جهة أخرى أعلنت المنطقة المركزية العسكرية عن اضطلاعها بمهام تأمين الانتخابات القادمة حيث ستتولى تأمين ثلاث محافظات من أصل تسع ستقام بها الانتخابات في المرحلة الأولى التي تنطلق في ٢٨ نوفمبر وتجرى الإعادة فيها في ٥ ديسمبر، وقالت مصادر لـالتحرير إن المنطقة المركزية

العسكرية تقوم بمهام التأمين في القاهرة الكبرى بمحافظة الثلاث، القاهرة والجيزة والقليوبية، التي تعد أكبر المحافظات من حيث الدوائر الانتخابية. وأشارت إلى أن وحدات من المشاة والقوات المصحوبة بعربات مدرعة ستتولى ضبط الأمن في هذه المحافظات أيام الانتخابات لدعم قوات الشرطة والتعامل مع أي مخططات لبت الفوضى وإرهاب الناخبين.

وأشارت المصادر إلى أن قوات الشرطة والجيش لن تتدخل في سير العملية الانتخابية داخل مقرات الانتخابات لكن عناصر أمنية مدربة بشكل خاص ستوجد داخل المقرات لمنع أي اعتداءات من البلطجية على الناخبين.

ومن المنتظر أن يعلن أعضاء المجلس العسكري خطة تأمين الانتخابات كاملة في مؤتمر صحفي مشترك مع قيادات الداخلية والقضاء الإثنين القادم، وهو المؤتمر الذي سيحسم فيه المجلس العسكري توزيع الأدوار بين الجيش والشرطة لتأمين الانتخابات القادمة.

29 Injured In Clashes During Coptic Rally

إصابة ٢٩ في معركة خلال مسيرة قبطية بشوارع شبرا

القاهرة . اشرف صادق وإسماعيل جمعة وهانى بركات: فى ظل وجود أمنى ضعيف، تحولت مسيرة نظمها الأقباط بعد ظهر أمس فى الذكرى الأربعين لأحداث ماسبيرو، التى وقعت الشهر الماضى إلى معركة بالحجارة وزجاجات البولتوف والأسلحة القارية بين المشاركين فيها وعدد من الأشخاص الجهوليين الذين اعترضوا المسيرة عقب فترة وجيزة من انطلاقها من نوران شبرا فى طريقها إلى ماسبيرو. وأسفرت الاشتباكات عن سقوط ٢٩ مصابا من الجانبين، فضلا عن تحطيم العديد من السيارات وواجهات المنازل والمحال التجارية فى شارع شبرا. بدأت الأحداث باحتكاكات مع

Thirty Six Organizations Received Suspicious Funding

Government Looks Into Borrowing From IMF



Due to deteriorating economic conditions within the country, Essam Sharaf's government is currently looking into seeking easy funding from international monetary institutions, including IMF. Sharaf's cabinet had previously declined funding offers from IMF in an effort to avoid excessive external debt.

Minister of Finance and Vice PM Hazem Al Biblawy had said the government was leaning towards diversifying its sources of funding, and warned against borrowing from local sources only.

MOPCO Crisis Continues



Employees of MOPCO, the Damietta fertilizer plant, have agreed to suspend their protests for one day in light of Friday’s Tahrir Square rally. Saaed Hamza, an employee of the company, revealed that they will resume protesting on Saturday and will stage their protests on the pavement of the Ministerial Cabinet’s headquarters.

Medhat Youseef, chair of MOPCO, had earlier denied that operation within the plant has been suspended. He also said rumors that MOPCO’s foreign investor had resorted to international mediation were untrue.

Al Awa: SCAF Operates With No Checks, Acts Suspiciously

قال الدكتور محمد سليم العوا، المرشح المحتمل للرئاسة، إن المجلس العسكري يعمل بلا رقيب، وإن حالة من الضباب والغموض تحيط بتصرفاته، محذرا من محاولات زرع الفتنة بين القوى السياسية لإفساد مليونية، اليوم، بالتحرير، أو حدوث صدام مع الجيش على غرار موقعة ماسبيرو.

وتعلقا على وثيقة المبادئ الدستورية وتعثر المفاوضات بين الحكومة والقوى السياسية بشأن تعديلاتها، طالب العوا في حوار مع معتر

الدمرداش ببرنامح «مصر الجديدة»، أمس الأول، الجيش بعدم معاندة القوى السياسية، داعيا إلى تجديد الوثيقة التي وصفها بالباطلة دستوريا، وأن الكرة الآن في ملعب المجلس العسكري، وعليه أن يتبرأ منها حتى تهدأ القوى السياسية.

وأضاف: «أرفض أي وثيقة إلزامية يصدرها أي شخص وليس فقط وثيقة السلم». ولا يجب أن يكون هناك فرض على إرادة الأمة من أي شخص أو جهة، مشيرا إلى أن الحكومة الحالية مؤقتة ومهمتها تسيير الأعمال فقط وليس التشريع أو إصدار وثائق دستورية. فيما أعرب عن قلقه بشأن

عدم إجراء الانتخابات، مؤكدا وجود قوى تريد تعطيلها. ودعا المرشح المحتمل في ندوة أخرى عقدها جامعة مصر للعلوم والتكنولوجيا في مدينة 6 أكتوبر، إلى أن يوجه المصريون اهتمامهم للانتخابات البرلمانية المقبلة، وحماية العملية الانتخابية، مطالبا القوات المسلحة بتولى هذا الدور، ووصف ما يصدر عن بعض المرشحين من توزيع للأطعمة والمشروبات لشراء الناخبين بأنها «أعمال تفلل من شأن الشعب المصري»، وأشار إلى أن النجاح في البرلمان لا يرتبط بشخص العضو المرشح ولكن بالكفاءة والبرنامج الانتخابي.

محمد سليم العوا

Mohamed Salim Al Awa, Islamic scholar and potential presidential candidate, said that the Supreme Council of Armed Forces was operating without a system of checks. Al Awa warned against efforts to incite differences between political powers, and warned against clashes with military forces.

Al Awa called on SCAF to refrain from supporting any political movements or candidates, and described Al Silmy's document as "illegitimate".

أعلن مدير الوكالة الأمريكية للتنمية الدولية والتر نورث عن برنامج منح جديدة لمصر لمواجهة أزمة ندرة المياه ومساعدة المصريين في التغلب على مشكلة ثبات جسرهم من مياه النيل. في ظل أزمة تقاسم حصص المياه مع دول حوض النيل، من خلال تخصيص ٤ ملايين دولار للمرحلة الأولى للمساهمة في مشروع تعزيز الالامركزية وإشراك مستخدمي المياه في إدارة نظم الري وتطوير بعض الترع في محافظات الصعيد.

وقال نورث. في كلمة ألقاها نيابة عنه رفاق فانوس مدير المشروع في مؤتمر صحفي على هامش ورشة عمل الإدارة المتكاملة للمياه بالعين السخنة أمس - إن المعونة الأمريكية قررت وضع خطة برنامج بميزانية ضخمة للمساهمة في رفع كفاءة إدارة المياه في مصر في هذه المرحلة وبالتنسيق مع وزارة الري المصرية. وذلك بعد الانتهاء من المشروع الحالي لإدارة المتكاملة للمياه في مساحة ٣,٤ مليون فدان وإنشاء ٧٢ رابطة تستخدم المياه.

وأكد ثروت أنه على الرغم من تخصيص المعونة الأمريكية للعديد من المنح الخاصة بدعم روابط المياه المصرية. فإن القانون المصري لا يسمح لهم بتلقي هذه المنح مما يعمل على تعطيل حصولهم على هذا الدعم.

من جانبه قال حسام فهمي، رئيس هيئة الصرف بوزارة الري، إن هناك تفكيراً بتعديل قانون الري والصرف ووضع على رأس أولويات الأجنحة التشريعية للبرلمان المنتخب الجديد الإسراع بفض إشكالية تعطيل عمل روابط مستخدمي المياه من المزارعين وإعطائها الصفة الاعترافية للعمل كمنظمات أهلية لتمكينها من تلقى أموال الدعم اللازمة للقيام بمهامها في تطهير الترع وأعمال الصيانة اللازمة لزام الأراضى في نطاق كل رابطة وبما يخفف عن الكاهل الحكومى ميزانيات ضخمة يتم تخصيصها سنويا لهذا الشأن.

ومن جانب آخر أكد د. هشام قنديل وزير الموارد المائية والري - في بيان صحفي أمس - أن الحكومة المصرية لم تتلق أى منحة يابانية جديدة لتجديد محطات الري والصرف ومحطة توشكى، ناهيا حصول وزارة الري على ١٢ مليون دولار من هيئة الجايكا اليابانية.

Walter North, head of the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) said a new grant program will be initiated to assist Egypt in combating the water scarcity issue, in light of conflict with other Nile basin countries over Egypt's water share.

North said USAID would cooperate with Egypt's Ministry of Irrigation and allocate a huge budget to assist in improving Egypt's water efficiency.
