The Dangers of Division

The Supreme Council of Armed Forces has become a point of debate, as hundreds of thousands of Egyptians made way to Tahrir Square demanding the immediate removal of SCAF and the establishment of a national salvation cabinet.

In a Friday of unity and in light of the absence of platforms, hundreds of thousands of demonstrators congregated in Tahrir Square, chanting "Legitimacy Comes From Tahrir, Leave Us Now, *Moushir* (Field Marshal)".

Protestors have condemned the use of force by security forces. Presidential hopeful Mohamed ElBaradei was notably present amidst the demonstrators, and conducted the Friday prayers among the protestors.

Meanwhile, new PM al-Ganzouri said he had asked for time in forming a new cabinet that will hopefully appease everyone in Tahrir Square. Al-Ganzouri said SCAF had given him full authority over the cabinet-to-be, and said it was likely that the new cabinet will not be formed prior to the parliamentary elections.

In the governorate of Al Wadi Al Gadid, protestors resorted to prayers, asking that Egypt safely comes out of the current state of instability and chaos.

Disagreement marked the protests in the governorate of Ismalia, as a number of protestors set for al-Abassiya to join the pro-SCAF demonstrators, while others went to Tahrir Square to protest against SCAF.

In Damietta, a similar scenario prevailed, where protesters were divided between those against and those in support of SCAF.

In Al Minya, mosque Imams prayed for the safety and security of Egypt, and warned against the loss of the status of the nation.

In Suez, protestors were able to maintain a peaceful atmosphere as they demonstrated against SCAF.

Kamal Al-Ganzouri Delegated To Form Cabinet with Full Authority

Former Prime Minister Kamal al-Ganzouri has been delegated by SCAF to form the new cabinet. Al-Ganzouri said SCAF has granted him full authority and that it wasn't likely that a cabinet will be formed prior to the parliamentary elections.

SCAF had recently issued a statement whereby it was decided that parliamentary elections would be held over the course of two days, not one.

Islamic movements had declared their support for SCAF's stance on recent events within the nation, and warned against following specific agendas.

Between Tahrir and Abasiyya – One Prayer, One Nation

Al Gomhoriyya had reported that Lieutenants al-Mullah and Etman of SCAF had met with leading figures within Egyptian media, and said that the current state of crisis witnessed by the country necessitates a unified approach.

Al Gomhoriyya had also reported on al-Ganzouri's attempts to form a new cabinet. Al Ganzouri said SCAF gave him unlimited authority in forming a national salvation government. Al Ganzouri also said the new cabinet would not be in place prior to the upcoming parliamentary elections.

Meanwhile, hundreds of thousands of protestors gathered in Tahrir Square, calling for the immediate transition of power from SCAF to a civilian government. Protestors in Tahrir Square said they were not pleased with al-Ganzouri as Prime Minister, and nominated ElBaradei, Aboul Fotouh, and Sabbahi to head the new government.

Pro-SCAF demonstrators in Abbasiyya chanted in favor of keeping SCAF in power. Thousands of demonstrators said Tahrir Square did not represent them.

Protestors in Tahrir Square were said to be divided over al-Ganzouri as Prime Minister. Some have accepted the appointment, while others had clearly rejected it.

SCAF had also recently decided to extend the voting period to two days as opposed to one, reaffirming that the elections will be held as scheduled.

Egypt Torn Between Flags, Caps, and Beards

Egypt witnessed yesterday three prominent demonstrations. The first protest was staged in Tahrir Square, where protestors were calling for the immediate transition of power by SCAF to a civilian government; the second was held in Abassiya by pro-SCAF demonstrators, who called for stability and acceptance of SCAF's statements; the third was held in Al Azhar mosque, organized by the Muslim Brotherhood, and titled "Save al-Aqsa".

Mohamed ElBaradei and Abdel Moneim Abul Fotouh joined protestors in Tahrir Square, whereas former head of the League of Arab States Amr Moussa issued a statement warning of deteriorating conditions in Egypt.

Minister of Interior Mansour El Essawi said security forces might not be able to secure the upcoming elections if the current state of chaos continues.

Protesters in Tahrir had declared their refusal for al-Ganzouri's assumption of the post of Prime Minister.

The Ministry of Health had said the death toll has risen to 41, while 65 ambulances were said to secure Tahrir Square.

Several open-ended protests were being staged in front of embassies all across the world, in support of Tahrir events and in condemnation of SCAF's policies.

SCAF Misses “Last Chance”

Al Tahrir described the Friday protests as a “sequel to the January revolution”. The newspaper reported on Mohamed ElBaradei joining protestors on Friday, chanting against SCAF.

ElBaradei told demonstrators he was not here to campaign for himself, but to stand up for what he believed in.

The newspaper likened the rallies to those that took place earlier this year, where protestors clearly rejected any attempts by SCAF to postpone the transition of power, and called for SCAF to leave power immediately.

Al Tahrir also said al-Ganzouri had stated that Field Marshal Tantawi had no intent to remain in power. Al-Ganzouri had asked for sufficient time to form the new cabinet, which will likely not be in place prior to the parliamentary elections.

Meanwhile, thousands have congregated in front of the Ministerial Cabinet headquarters, clearly condemning the choice of al-Ganzouri as prime minister for the upcoming period.

Protestors had said they believed al-Ganzouri was symbolic of the old regime, and noted that many ministers who worked with al-Ganzouri were now behind bars, stating this was more of a reason to reject his appointment.

Enough Is Enough

Hundreds of thousands of protestors gathered in Tahrir Square on Friday, calling for the immediate transition of power from SCAF to a body of civilians.

Muslim Brotherhood and Abassiya Protests Support Ganzouri as PM

For more than one week, Tahrir Square has been witnessing a blood bath, with the death toll rising to 41 according to Ministry of Health statistics.

Chants in the square called for the removal of Field Marshal Tantawi, as thousands congregated and called for the formation of a national salvation government.

A number of pro-SCAF protests were being staged in Alexandria and Abassiya. Notably, the Muslim Brotherhood was absent from Tahrir Square on Friday. Mahmoud Ghozlan, spokesperson of the MB, said they were aware that the Brotherhood had "lost" by boycotting the rallies.

Tahrir Protestors Congregate, Continue Revolution

Al Shorouk newspaper also reported on hundreds of thousands of protestors congregating in Tahrir Square, calling for the immediate transition of power from SCAF to a civilian government.

During Friday's sermon, Imam Mathar Shaheen stressed the importance of forming a national salvation government, one that stems from Tahrir Square. He recommended names that included Mohamed ElBaradei and Abdel Moneim Abul Fotouh and Hamdein Sabbahi.

The newspaper reported on Mohamed ElBaradei's participation in the protests, where he chanted against SCAF and said that the "martyr's blood would not go to waste."

Al Shorouk said political movements reached the consensus that al-Ganzouri was a "respectable figure", but said they did not believe he can effectively administer the upcoming period.

Sabbahi: Al Ganzouri is "Respectable" ... Protestors Believe He Is Part of Old Regime

«صباحي»: الجنزوري محل تقدير.. والثوار يرونه جزءاً من النظام السابق
«أبو الفتوح والبرادعي وعيسى وعبد العزيز» الأصلاح لتشكيل الحكومة

كتب - محمد عبدالقادر،
قال حمدين صباحي، المرشح المحتمل لرئاسة الجمهورية، إن الدكتور كمال الجنزوري محل احترام وتقدير، ولكن المهم هو كيف يراء ثوار التحرير، فهم يرونه جزءاً من النظام السابق.

وأضاف «صباحي»، في حوار مع الزميل مجدى الجلاد على قناة «سى. بي. سى» أمس: طرحنا تشكيل حكومة إنقاذ وطني لها صلاحيات كاملة وتوقفت المشكلة عند من يشكها»، وقال: «من يصلح لتشكيل الوزارة الآن هو الدكتور محمد البرادعي وعبدالمعتم أبو الفتوح وحسام عيسى والمستشار زكريا عبدالعزيز»، مشيراً إلى ضرورة أن تعبر حكومة الإنقاذ الوطني عن الثورة وأن يرضى عنها ميدان التحرير لأنه طرف في الأزمة.

ورداً على سؤال «الجلاد» ما إذا كان سيقبل الوزارة إذا عرضت عليه في هذا الوقت، قال إنه لا يستطيع أن يرفض تشكيل الوزارة إذا كان في إمكانه تقديم ما يخرج مصر من أزمتها. وتابع: «إذا خفنا كلها من تحمل مسؤولية تشكيل الوزارة فمن يتحملها». واشترط «صباحي» حصوله على صلاحيات كاملة وأنه سيضم فيها جميع التيارات السياسية ولن يستبعد أحداً.

وأعرب «صباحي» عن تعجبه من تجاهل استشارة أصحاب الخبرة في الوقت الذي تملك فيه مصر العشرات من المتخصصين الذين يجيدون التصح والتخليط، وبالرغم من ذلك لا يؤخذ برأيهم، وقال إنه ليس لزاماً أن يعين أصحاب الخبرة في المناصب التنفيذية، ولكن يمكن الاستعانة بهم كجهات استشارية.

وعن الأزمة التي تمر بها. قال «صباحي»: «إن هناك عجزاً واضحاً في إدارة الفترة الانتقالية، وهو إحساسنا بأن مصر واقفة في مكانها بلا أي تقدم، وهناك إحساس عام لدى الشعب بأن رأيه واختياراته لا تقدر ولا يؤخذ بها ولا تحظى باحترام».

وعبر «صباحي» عن اندهاشه من موقف الإخوان المسلمين لأنهم لم ينزلوا ميدان التحرير وقدموا أسباباً منطقية لذلك، ولكن نزولهم لمليونية «من أجل الأقصى» في هذا الوقت متناقض وقد يساء تفسيره، لأنها قد تقصر بأنها مناوئة لمطالب التحرير.

Presidential hopeful Hamdeen Sabbahi said new Prime Minister Kamal al-Ganzouri was a "respectable man", but that it was more important for the revolutionaries in Tahrir to accept him.

When asked if he would be willing to assume the post of Prime Minister, Sabbahi said he would be willing to do anything to bring Egypt out of its current crisis.

Assmaa Mahfouz: We Will Hold Those Mistaken Accountable, Return The Rights of the Poor

أسماء محفوزة: سنحاسب المخطئ ونجلب للفقير حقه
ترشحي محاولة لكسر «التابوهات».. ولا أخشى الفلول والـ٩٤ رجلاً



تعد أكثر الشخصيات المثيرة للجدل، قبل وبعد ٢٥ يناير، هي واحدة من أشهر شباب الثورة، وكان لها أكثر من مشاركة في التوقيعات الاحتجاجية ضد المحاكمات العسكرية للمدنيين، هي أسماء محفوزة التي تناهض على المقعد القوي في دائرة مقر الرئيس المخلوع حسني مبارك «مصر الجديدة» والزهرة ويدر والشروق، لتخطي معنى، وإن لم يكن مضموداً، مطنطه «نحن شباب الثورة نعلمنا الرئيس وتناقض في دائرته».

■ كيف اتخذت قرار تخطي الانتخابات؟
 قرار تخطي الانتخابات على المقعد القوي، لم يكن للمناقشة فقط، لكن لإعلان موقف، واختراق الشارع والتكاثف اليمتددة، وكسر أهم وأكبر التابوهات، وهو مناقشة الشباب للتكاثف الأثنياء، والمرأة للرجال، حيث أواجه ٩٤ رجلاً، من بينهم مرشح للإخوان، والدكتور عمرو حمزاوي، وعدد كبير من مرشحي الفلول. كما أن لدى مبررات أخرى لتخطي الانتخابات، أهمها أننا كشباب نقدر نعلمنا المخطئ ونجيب حق الفقير من الحكومة، أيا كانت، داخل البرلمان أو خارجه، وعلشان أمثل شباب نزلوا الشارع في وقت كان كثير من توجية ألق فاعدين في بورتهم.

■ ما أبرز المشكلات التي تواجهك في حملتك الانتخابية؟
 أبرز المشكلات هي قلة الأموال والشائعات التي تملأ الشارع عن شباب الثورة، وعن بشكل شخصي، مثل امتلاك

سيرة من إم، وهيللا في مصر الجديدة، إضافة إلى اتهامات بالتحويل الأجنبي والسعي لانتزاع على الجيش وهدم البلاد، والمثوية أنتي لا أمك رحمة هياذ أساساً، وأمكن في شارع أحمد عصمت، والذي مدير إدارة سابق في وزارة التعليم، ولي أخ ضابط شرطة سابق، وأخر ضابط بالقوات المسلحة، وأخت مهندسة، وأسنا أترباء، ككتنا والحمد لله على قد حالتنا، وأنا أسنا بل بتعجب، كيف أعمل على كسر الجيش وإهائته وأخى جزء منه؟

■ ما الخطيئة أهل العائشة عشك، وما تمسيتيه متهم خلال جولتك؟
 هناك اعتياد طبيعي لشارع في مسألة الانتخابات، هو أن الناس لا تعرف سوى الإخوان ومشاهير الحزب الوطني، ككتنا كتشباب للثورة، وفي حزب التيار المصري الذي أنتي إليه، نسعي لكسر كل تلك المخاوف، ويكفي أننا كنا في وقت من الأوقات نزل إلى الشارع ونواجه الشرطة دون خوف، فمن يظن أننا نخشى من فلول أو شائعات فهو واهم، ولا يعرفنا.

■ ماذا عن دعواتك الانتخابية؟
 البعض يعتقد أن جائزة «ساحر» مبلغ كبير، لكنها ١٠ آلاف يورو فقط، وسأستأجرها آخر ديسمبر، وأعتد على التبرعات المئوية ومجهودنا على الأرض، بالتزول والتحرك.

Assmaa Mahfouz has revealed through an interview given to Al Tahrir newspaper her intent to run in the upcoming parliamentary elections. Mahfouz said some of the biggest obstacles facing her were lack of funding and widespread rumors.

Kamal Al Ganzouri: Authority Granted Is Unprecedented

الدكتور كمال الجنزوري في مؤتمر صحفي:
حصلت على صلاحيات كاملة وغير مسبوقه طوال ٦٠ عاما
الحكومة الجديدة لن تشكل قبل انتخابات المرحلة الأولى

 أكد الدكتور كمال الجنزوري رئيس الوزراء المكلف بتشكيل حكومة الإنقاذ الوطني أن له صلاحيات كاملة لتنفيذ مسؤولياته. مشدداً على أنه جاء لخدمة الشعب.
 جاء ذلك في مؤتمر صحفي عقده الدكتور الجنزوري مساء أمس.
 وأضاف الدكتور كمال الجنزوري أنه سيحصل على الصلاحيات الكاملة التي تعطيه القدرة والثقة على خدمة هذا البلد، مشيراً إلى أنه سيشكل حكومة برلمانية عتية الشعب كله.
 قال الجنزوري إنه سيسعى لاختيار أعضاء الحكومة القادمة خلال الفترة القريبة القادمة، لافتاً إلى أنه من الصعب تشكيل الحكومة قبل انطلاق الانتخابات البرلمانية المقررة يوم الاثنين المقبل.
 كان المشير محمد حسين طنطاوي القائد العام ورئيس المجلس الأعلى للقوات المسلحة قد أصدر قراراً في وقت سابق أمس بتعيين الدكتور كمال الجنزوري رئيساً للوزراء وتكليفه بتشكيل حكومة إنقاذ وطني، ومخحه كافة الصلاحيات التي تعارفه على أداء مهمته بكفاءة تامة.
 قال الدكتور كمال الجنزوري رئيس الوزراء المكلف بتشكيل حكومة الإنقاذ الوطني إنه أجرى عدة لقاءات مع المشير محمد حسين طنطاوي القائد العام ورئيس المجلس الأعلى للقوات المسلحة فوجهاً يتحقق بالوزارة الجديدة التي سيتولى رئاستها.
 وأضاف الجنزوري " لقد تم تكليفني بتشكيل الوزارة اليوم، وسأسعى خلال الفترة القريبة القادمة في تشكيل الوزارة ولكن لم يبدأ بعد الحديث مع أحد".
 أكد الدكتور كمال الجنزوري رئيس الوزراء الجديد المكلف بتشكيل حكومة الإنقاذ الوطني أنه سيسمح على صلاحيات كاملة وغير مسبوقه وتم يحصل عليها أي رئيس وزراء سابق خلال الـ ٦٠ عاماً السابقة حيث كان رئيس الجمهورية يصدر قراراً بتفويض رئيس الوزراء في بعض سلطاته وإن التعديلات الجديدة التي أجريت بمنح رئيس الوزراء صلاحيات كاملة تفوق بكثير سلطات رئيس الجمهورية في

 وأضاف الجنزوري أنه كان دائماً صاحب مقولة أي مسئول سواء وزير أو محافظ لا بد أن يصدر القرار المناسب في الوقت المناسب أو القوي دون الرجوع إلى المسئول الأعلى وإن أي مسئول ومسئول المسئول الأعلى منه لا يستحق تولى المسئولية.
 وتابع الجنزوري قائلًا: "سأستخذ الصلاحيات الكاملة لكي أقوم بخدمة هذا البلد الذي شاء القدر أن أتى لكي أقف اليوم لأتكلم بعد غياب أكثر من عشر سنوات".

 وتابع قائلًا "إن المجموعة الوزارية كما أرى وأسمع أنها جيدة ولكن التحدي الأكبر سيمر لا أعرفه، لكن الحكم الحقيقي في تشكيل الوزارة الجديدة هو تحقيق ما نرجوه لهذا البلد، وفي نفس الوقت بعد القبول لدى كافة الشعب وبالتالي ليس هناك بدائل الوزارة شخصيات أريد دعم أشخاص من خارج الوزارة إلا للمصالح العام أيضاً".
 ودعا الجنزوري التلافيفات شباب الثورة وكافة التيارات الحزبية والسياسية إلى طرح بعض الأسماء الذين يتفقون فيها للتحصول في الوزارة الجديدة من أجل مراجعتها، مشيراً إلى أنه لا يوجد في ذهنه الآن أسماء محددة، ولكنه مشغول فقط بأن يقوم بواجبه على أكمل وجه لخدمة بلد في هذه المرحلة".

Prime Minister Kamal al-Ganzouri held a press conference, whereby he said authorities granted to him by SCAF were "unprecedented."

Al-Ganzouri said it was unlikely that the new cabinet will be formed prior to the parliamentary elections on Monday.
