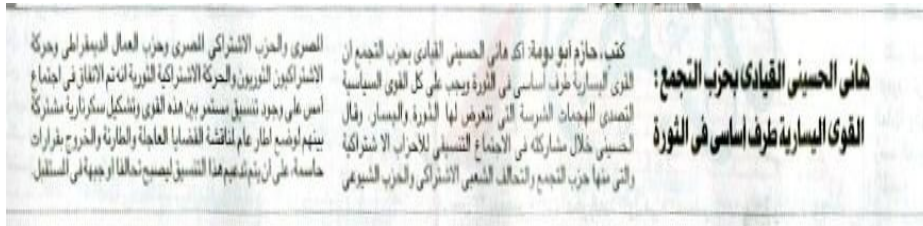
Abu Ismail Rejects a Consensual President

Elections Updates



The Administrative Court issued a ruling to repeat the elections at al-Husainiya constituency.

A candidate that had died over a month ago got a considerable number of voices in the constituency. Hence the elections were canceled and, according to the court ruling, they are to be repeated again.

Campaigns and preparations for the third phase of elections to the People Assembly have started.

Hasnaa al-Sahrif referred to the tribal belonging influence on the race in North Sinai.

In al-Wadi al-Jadid, the biggest Egyptian governorate, 86 candidates are competing.



Haniyeh in Cairo for Talks with Intelligence Officers, FJP Leaders



Head of the Hamas government in Gaza City Ismail Haniyeh arrived in Cairo, the first visit he makes outside Gaza since Israel ended its 4-year blockade of the Palestinian enclave.

Haniyeh's Egypt visit is the first leg of a regional whistle-stop tour that will take him later to Sudan, Qatar, Bahrain, Tunisia and Turkey.

During his two-day stay in Cairo, Haniyeh will meet with Intelligence Chief Mourad Mowafi. He is expected to hold a meeting with senior leaders of the Freedom and Justice Party, the political arm of the Muslim Brotherhood.

Number of Sitters-In Mounts in Tahrir Square



The numbers of tents set up in Tahrir Square increased to 22 as protesters continue to flock to the iconic area.

Engineers of the Arab Contractors Company resumed restoration works at the Scientific Academy for the second day running.

The traffic movement went smoothly inside the square.

In the Cabinet area, Army forces allowed the citizens to walk in and out to two roads adjacent to the Kasr Al-Aini Street without checking their IDs for the first time.

Army Forces had blocked the Cabinet area from all sides: Mansour, Al-Falaki and Kasr Al-Aini streets and erected concrete barricades in Sheikh Rihan and Mohamed Mahmoud streets.

FJP Head, Mohamed El-Morsy, attended a press conference in Gharbia governorate to support the party's candidates there.

Serious discussions are currently taking place inside the Salafi current to decide who they are going to nominate in the presidential elections.

The NCHR stated that most of the violations of the first phase of the elections were avoided in the second phase. The vote count was more organized and witnessed less administrative errors.

Moheet, an Arabic Media Network, published a document on its website yesterday showing that Israel has offered Mubarak, his government, and NDP leaders' asylum 4 days after Mubarak has stepped down.

Israeli Ambassador to Egypt Isaac Levanon has talked to Zakaria Azmi, former chief of presidential staff, on February 15th, Azmi welcomed the offer.

The document also said they talked to Safwat El-Sheriff, former speaker of the Shura Council, who said that the public protests will end soon and nothing requires them to leave the country.

Abul Fotooh: FJP Do Not Respect Their Word



Presidential Candidate, Abd El-Moneil Abul Fotooh, said that the former regime is still running the country from Tora prison.

He accused FJP of not abiding by its own promises; they previously announced they will nominate only 50% to win less than 30% of the parliamentary elections; however, they nominated 99% and won over 60%.

The Shura Council has no value, it was used by the former regime to increase their immunity while costing 300 million, he said.

Advisory Council Examines Criteria for Constituent Assembly Members



The Advisory Council announced SCAF’s approval for ending Shura elections by February 22nd on two phases only instead of three. Shura Elections will be held on January 29th.

By the end of February the People’s Assembly and Shura Council will hold a joint session to select Constituent Assembly members. However, the transitional period still ends in June as changing the date of the Shura elections was to give the Constituent Assembly more time to draft the constitution.

Four new members joined the Council; Osama El-Ghazaly Harb, Mona Makram Ebeid, Sekeena Foud and Mohamed Abd El-Gawad.

The Council invited the Minister of Interior to attend Tuesday’s session to discuss the Ministry’s efforts to fix the state of security chaos.

In Saturday’s session, legal expert, Kamal Abul Magd presented 14 models from the western countries for the formation of the Constituent Assembly.

Court Accepts Challenge by Khaled Saeed's Family



An Alexandria court accepted a challenge filed by the family of Khaled Saeed, a young Egyptian who was beaten to death by two police officers and is said to be the spark that ignited the Egyptian revolution.

Saeed's family appealed a court ruling imprisoning the two police officers for seven years each.

The family's lawyer, Mahmoud el-Afifi, said the court had based its verdict on unsubstantiated evidence that Saeed was a drug user. The family is seeking harsher rulings against the two.

Shura Council Elections Moved to Earlier Date



SCAF agreed to move the elections of the Shura Council, upper house of parliament, to an earlier date.

The elections will be held earlier to end on February 22 instead of mid March as proposed by Chairman of the High Elections Commission (HEC) Abdel-Moez Ibrahim, an official source said.

SCAF is expected to issue a decree to shorten the transitional period by holding the elections on two phases instead of three, the source added.

Salafist Asalah Party Against Christmas Greetings



General Adel Afifi, head of Salafist al-Asalah Party declared that the party would not greet Copts on Christmas.

“There is a psychological barrier between us that prevent us, as a party, from greeting them on Christmas and other holidays,” he said.

“They call us invaders and occupiers ... and they call the West to liberate Egypt from Islamists,” he argued adding: “we want them to reassure us that they will not call on the West to fight us.”

He claimed that Copts had addressed the West and Israel as a role model for them who need to help them against “Islamist invaders.”

“We will not be partners [with them]. To accept them as partners they need to give up this aggressive stand against us.

“This is a sectarian topic, and I will not discuss it,” said Yusri Hamad, head of Salafist al-Nour Party.

Meanwhile, Mufti of Egypt Ali Gomaa greeted Copts considering Christmas to be a naissance of “the good, peace and love” for all human beings.

Sawiris: My Conflict with the Muslim Brotherhood is Personal



Egyptian tycoon Naib Sawiris accused the Muslim Brotherhood (B) of receiving \$100 million from Qatar to fund their electoral campaign. Sawiris claimed that an Arab Country President informed him about the issue.

Sawiris called on the MB to clarify the sources of their funds.

Sawiris said he was seriously concerned about the future of liberalism in Egypt.

In an interview with al-Haya 2 TV channel, Sawiris stated that his conflict with the Muslim Brotherhood was personal of a religious identity.

He said that most of his friends were Muslims and that the directress of his office was veiled and 97% of the employees in his businesses were Muslims too.

“Here I ask the businessmen who are members of the Muslim Brotherhood: how many Copts work for you?”

Sawiris denied what was rumored about him encouraging Copts to emigrate.

Responding to a question about the possibility of cooperating with a coalition government with the Muslim Brotherhood, Sawiris said he was ready to do anything that serves Egypt’s interests.

Sawiris said the two phases of parliamentary elections were 80% fair in spite of some irregularities.

Sawiris believes that the new Constitution should express all Egyptians.

Religious Scholars: Whoever Died for Freedom of his Country is a Martyr



Dr. Mohamed El-Shahat El-Gendi, a member of the Islamic Research Academy, said protesters are divided into various groups; some of them go out to call for the freedom of their country and to pursue the demands of the January 25 revolution, while others infiltrate among them to create chaos and sabotage.

“We cannot generalize and call all those who died in these protests martyrs. People who participated in the protests have different backgrounds and positions. Those who came out to pursue the rights and just demands of our people, and were killed, are considered martyrs. Those who took off to the streets and received money to create chaos and instability in our country can never be called martyrs,” El-Gendi said.

He said that bloody clashes must come to an end and this applies to all parties involved; SCAF, the government, political parties, revolutionaries and figures of the former regime.

An influential state-owned [Egyptian Arabic language](#) daily [newspaper](#). It was established in 1954.

❖ **Al-Shorouk: Egyptian daily independent newspaper**
