### El-Ganzouri to Give Speech to Parliament

القاهرة - يهوء مياضرو، يلي الدكتور كمال الجنزوري رئيس مجلس الوزراء، البيان الأول أمام برلمان الثورة غدا، ويعرض الجنزوري في بيان خطط الحكومة وبرامجها منذ توليه المسؤولية. وخلال عرضة اللجنة الفوجية الأزمات سواء الاقتصادية والأمنية يدفع خطة الاستثمار للتمويل من الوحدة الرأسمالية.

Prime Minister Dr. Kamal El-Ganzouri will give his first statement to the parliament tomorrow. His statement will include the government's plans and policies since it assumed responsibility until now. He will also present future policies designed to solve current economic and security crises.

Informed sources revealed that the government will announce setting the minimum wages to be 800EGP instead of 700EGP starting from July 2012. This is a step in the government's plan to increase minimum wages to reach 1200EGP within 5 years. The government will also declare that it will not impose any new taxes in its effort to maintain a social perspective in its economic and financial plans.

The parliament, headed by Dr. Saad El-Katatni, will discuss tomorrow the report of the constitutional and legislative committee on the two draft laws presented by MP Mohamed Al-Omda and MP Gamal Hanafi to amend some of the provisions of the presidential elections law.

The parliament will also take a final decision to increase the compensations given to the families of the revolution's martyrs to reach 100.000EGP each.

Five hearings, requested by Members of Parliament, will be scheduled for the Prime Minister and Ministers of Local Development, Water Resources and Agriculture, Electricity, and Finance. They will address problems of slums, environmental degradation, waste of public funds in some of the projects of power stations and high levels of groundwater in Al-Agami area.

### Tahrir Square Protesters Demand Mubarak be Tried for Treason



A number of protesters continued their sit-in in Tahrir Square demanding the ruling authorities to charge Mubarak with high treason. They criticized the Mubarak trial and described it as "fake justice" and confirmed that the parliament is just a "figurehead." They also demanded that SCAF leaves power and reaffirmed the revolutionary legitimacy of Tahrir Square.

Protesters in Tahrir Square chanted yesterday anti-SCAF slogans, refusing all the measures taken by SCAF to prepare for presidential elections.

They defended April 6 movement as one of the revolutionary forces. They also said they have papers which prove that corruption of officials continued after the revolution.

Protesters believe that efforts are made to hinder the revolution and that the next few days might witness assassinations of revolutionary figures. They condemned the attack against Dr. Abdel Moneim Aboul Fotouh, potential presidential candidate, and expected more attacks to take place if the situation remained as it is.

They criticized the parliament and questioned its ability to take immediate decisions which can solve the current crises in the country.

## Al-Nour Rejects Consensus Presidential Candidate Idea



Salafist Al-Nour Party reiterated its rejection of having a consensus presidential candidate, saying that a president should not be elected in closed rooms.

The party wants a president with a national agenda and who at the same time respects Islamic thinking, party spokesman Nader Bakar said.

Bakar said the interior minister should be questioned over his decision to suspend beard-growing officers from work.

## 100 Public Figures Launch "President Initiative"



Intensive meetings were held over the past two weeks by 100 public figures to discuss backing a presidential candidate and choosing two presidential aides, said political researcher Amar Ali Hassan.

In two days, the names selected for the three positions will be announced, Hassan said.

Al-Masry Al-Yom learned those public figures have been meeting secretly to reach consensus on certain names.

They were mulling the nomination of former IAEA chief Mohamed el-Baradei in case he decides to get back to the presidential race, Al-Masry Al-Yom reported.

### Car Runs into MP Who Called for Moving Mubarak to Prison Hospital



Undersecretary of the Health Committee at the People’s Assembly, Hassan el-Brence, was rammed into by a truck in Beheria governorate on Friday.

Brence, an MP of the Freedom and Justice Party, sustained fractures and injuries and was taken to a hospital in Alexandria.

He is in a critical condition.

Brence was among a parliamentary delegation that visited Tora Prison Hospital and recommended that former president Hosni Mubarak be moved there.

The Interior Ministry considered the incident a normal traffic accident. It also denied reports that the MP’s car was showered with a hail of bullets.

The FJP, meanwhile, issued a statement saying that while Brence was driving from Kafr El-Dawar to Alexandria, a vehicle blocked his way and another crashed into him from the back.

FJP media office director in Alexandria Ahmed Hassan said the incident took place after Brence had received several death threats.

### Ahly Fans Kick Out Governor of Memorial Ceremony



A number of die-hard fans of Al-Ahly football club, known as Ultras, blasted out at Sharqiya Governor Azzazi Ali Azzazi and kicked him out of a memorial ceremony held in honor of one of the Port Said victims.

The angry fans, joined by students of Zaqaziq University students, forced the governor out of the ceremony and asked him to resign.

One of the fans also rubbished Muslim Brotherhood members attending the ceremony and accused the group of selling the revolution.

## Baradei Forms New Political Entity Encompassing Revolution Youth



A number of political figures decided to establish a new political entity with the aim of unifying all thoughts and stances in the coming phase.

The meeting was attended by former IAEA chief Mohamed el-Baradei, who recently withdrew from the presidential elections, writer Alaa el-Aswani and journalist Salah Eissa, among others.

The entity will bring together all revolution youths under one ceiling.

Proposals were presented to transform the entity into a political party.

The entity will, however, be declared officially in a press conference to give more details about its mechanism.



## Two Parties Agree to Merge



Leaders from the Egyptian Democratic Party and Justice Party met on Friday to tackle means to merge the two parties together to be able to compete in the political life.

The process is meant to bring civil parties, with similar ideologies, under one wing to be stronger, said Egyptian Democratic Party member Ehab el-Kharat.

It would, however, need several months to be materialized on the ground, Kharat said.

Egyptians feel much less safe than they did before the "Arab Spring" uprising, a new Gallup poll has found. Pollsters found the percentage of Egyptians who said they feel safe walking alone at night in their neighborhood dropped to 47% from 82% since the revolution.

Gallup cautioned that the uneasiness doesn't necessarily mean there is more crime. An earlier poll found that Egyptians' sense of safety differed depending on what television stations they watched. The Times reported there are few reliable statistics on how much crime has actually risen in Egypt.

### **Abo Ismail: Presidential Elections before Drafting Constitution**

In an interview with Al-Gomhoreya newspaper, Sheikh Hazem Salah Abo Ismail, potential presidential candidate, said that Egypt is facing serious challenges that threaten the achievements of the January 25 revolution.

He criticized the selectivity and bias of media coverage of the news surrounding Islamist parties or leaders.

"I believe an honest politician should analyze events and take the right actions to respond to them, instead of limiting himself to giving speeches and issuing statements," Abo Ismail said.

He described the phase in which Egypt is going through as a "critical juncture," which will determine the country's future.

He said if he came to power he would seek to impose an economic boycott against Israel and this will restore some of the balance of power between the two country.

Abo Ismail said a presidential regime is better than parliamentary one, given that the massive range of powers the former presidents of the country enjoyed would be restricted.

## Israel Says Extensive Terrorist Activity in Sinai

### قوات الاحتلال الإسرائيلي تقتحم «الأقصى» وتصيب ٣٠ فلسطينياً من المصلين

هاجمت قوات الاحتلال الإسرائيلي، المصلين في الحرم القدسي بالهراوات والرصاص المطاطي وقنابل الغاز المسيل للدموع مما أسفر عن إصابة أكثر من ثلاثين من المصلين معظمهم من النساء. وذكر راديو إسرائيل باللغة العبرية أن الشرطة اعتقلت عشرات الشبان الفلسطينيين عقب صلاة الجمعة بدعوى إلقاءهم الحجارة على شرطة الاحتلال قرب باب الخفارية، حيث دارت مواجهات عنيفة بين جيش الاحتلال الإسرائيلي وشبان فلسطينيين في باحات المسجد الأقصى المبارك. وقال شهود عيان إن قوات وشرطة الاحتلال هاجمت بالمضرب والغاز المسيل للدموع الشبان الفلسطينيين الذين تظاهروا عقب الصلاة رفضاً لسياسة التهويد والاحتفالات المتكررة التي تشهدها قوات الاحتلال وقطعان مستوطنيه للحرم القدسي. كانت ساحات ومساحات ومواقف المسجد الأقصى المبارك قد شهدت تجمعات ضخمة بالمصلين من مدينة القدس وحواحيها وأحيائها وبلداتها بالإضافة إلى المصلين الوافدين من مختلف التجمعات السكانية داخل الأراضي المحتلة عام ٤٨. وخلال المواجهات حطقت طائرة عمودية إسرائيلية في أجواء المسجد الأقصى، وتلقت بعدها مواجهات عنيفة في منطقة باب حطة بالبلدة القديمة من القدس، وفي حي رأس العامود القريب من المسجد الأقصى. وقالت مؤسسة الأقصى للوقف والتراث في بيان لها إن قوات كثيرة من جيش الاحتلال اقتحمت المسجد الأقصى بعد الانتهاء من صلاة الجمعة مباشرة، وقامت بالاعتداء على المصلين بالهراوات والقنابل المسيلة للدموع مما أدى إلى وقوع عدد من الإصابات، أغلبها حالات اختناق، وأسفقت قوات الاحتلال أبواب الجامع القبلي المسننوق وأغلق أبواب المسجد الأقصى المبارك من جهتها. تحدثت مؤسسة الأقصى، بالجرمة الإسرائيلية، وقالت: «إن ما حدث في المسجد الأقصى يؤكد ما حذرنا منه تكررأً بشأن الاحتلال يخطط لتصفية اعتماداته على المسجد الأقصى، الأمر الذي يستدعي تحركاً إسلامياً عربياً فلسطينياً لإنقاذ المسجد الأقصى».

Israeli Army recently has been witnessing extensive terrorist activity in the Sinai Peninsula involving terrorists from the Gaza Strip.

Nevertheless, the Israeli military establishment does not have sufficient intelligence on the non-Gaza based terror cells operating from Sinai. It has identified an Islamization trend led by Egypt's Salafist movement which influences young Bedouins in the region, Israeli newspaper Yediot Ahronot reported.

This is manifested in aid given to terrorist cells who require transport which at times is done with no charge, for ideological motives. The young Bedouins, who make a living out of smuggling, hold almost daily fire exchanges with Egyptian forces which have left more than 20 officers wounded in the last couple of months.

The Israeli army is also facing an infiltration problem on the Egypt border.

## MB Demanded Haniyeh Gives a Speech from Al-Azhar's Pulpit



After attending the Friday prayers, Muslim Brotherhood members insisted that Hamas Leader Ismail Haniyeh gives a speech from Al-Azhar's pulpit. Some of Al-Azhar's scholars objected over security concerns.

Haniyeh is the first Palestinian leader who gives a speech to Egyptians from Al-Azhar's pulpit. He praised Arab revolutions and said they pave the way for liberating Al-Aqsa Mosque. He reaffirmed Hamas' commitment towards the right of Palestinians in their lands and the right of Palestinian refugees to return to their stolen lands.

"We will never recognize Israel," Haniyeh said. Many Muslim Brotherhood leaders were standing in lines to welcome Haniyeh. A delegation of Syrian revolutionary activists was also present, Haniyeh expressed the support of the Palestinian people to the Syrian revolution.

## Judicial Authority and Parliament's Legislations



Senior Judge Ahmed Al-Zend, Head of the Judges' Club, has continuously attacked Members of the Parliament and their demands to remove the Public Prosecutor from his position. However, he surprised everyone by organizing a meeting between him, along with heads of judges' clubs in the governorates, and the Speaker of People's Assembly.

Head of the Judges' Club in Bani Suf told Al-Tahrir newspaper that the Speaker of the People's Assembly confirmed to judges that the assembly will not discuss the judicial authority draft law. Al-Katatni demanded judges to agree on a draft law to be presented to the parliament for legislation.

A meeting between Al-Zend and Minister of Justice Senior Judge Adel Abd Al-Hamid is scheduled next week to reach an agreement on the judicial authority draft law.

## Beshri: I Have Nothing to Do With Initiatives on Choosing Consensus Islamist Candidate



Jurist Tareq el-Beshri denied participating in any commissions to select an Islamist candidate for the presidential elections.

He also refuted claims that he floated an initiative to select one of the following three Islamist presidential candidates: Mohamed Selim el-Awwa, Abdel-Moneim Abul-Fotouh and Hazem Abu-Ismael.

He declined to comment on reports that the Muslim Brotherhood group had contacted him to be its candidate in the presidential race.

### Political Assassinations Threaten the Transitional Phase



Dr. Abdel Moneim Aboul Fotouh, potential presidential candidate, was attacked yesterday by three masked men who were carrying machine guns. They stopped his car on the Ring Road as he was returning from an electoral conference in Al-Menoufia. Thugs beat Aboul Fotouh on his head with the butt of the machine gun. He was transferred to New Cairo Hospital where he received treatment and was released from hospital on Friday morning after his condition became stable.

Dozens of Aboul Fotouh's supporters and members of his campaign rushed to the hospital to make sure he was alright. Also, a number of MB leaders Hamdeen Sabahi, potential presidential candidate, and security officials visited him in the hospital.

MP Dr. Hassan Al-Brins, head of the health committee of the People's Assembly, was subjected to an assassination attempt on Friday while he was returning from Alexandria.

A truck cut off the road in front of his car which caused him to crash. Al-Brins was famous for proposing the transfer of Mubarak from the International Medical Center to Torah Prison Hospital. He had received assassination threats and confirmed the accident was intentional.

## Thousands Participate in 'Supporting the Aqsa Mosque' Friday Protests



"Generation after another, we will hate you Israel" and "Zahar and Haniyeh, do not abandon your rifle," were two of the slogans thousands of protesters were chanting on Friday in Al-Azhar Mosque during the protests titled "Supporting the Aqsa Mosque."

Violent clashes broke out between Israeli occupation forces and people praying in Al-Aqsa Mosque after the Israeli forces stormed the southern side of Al-Aqsa courtyards. The Israeli forces used rubber bullets, sound bombs and tear gas against protesters who gathered to prevent the settlers' attempts to break into the Aqsa Mosque.

Protesters in Cairo condemned the Israeli attacks against the Aqsa Mosque and their attempts to judaize Al-Quds (Jerusalem).

Hamas Leader Ismail Haniyeh attended the Friday prayer in Al-Azhar Mosque and people demanded he gives a speech. Haniyeh said in his speech that the Arab spring revolutions are writing a new history for Arabs and Muslims and will be the first step towards liberating Palestine. He mentioned that Al-Quds and Gaza are facing continuous occupation campaigns and shelling by Zionist forces. He confirmed that Palestinians will never abandon their land and they will never recognize Israel.
