A "Sandal," this is how al-Tahrir described the lift of travel ban that was imposed on foreigners involved in illegal activities of NGOs in Egypt.

The paper launched a barrage of criticism against the decision and blamed SCAF for alienating Egypt's sovereignty.

Al-Tahrir mentioned that the judicial authorities released the foreign suspects by SCAF's orders.

The suspects were released for a L.E 38-billion-bail.

While the Muslim Brotherhood declared that the Judiciary in Egypt was "penetrated" by other powers, the US Congress thanked the Muslim Brotherhood's leadership for playing a crucial role in solving the problem.

New York Times referred to some fund deals behind the release of the suspects.



Head of Cairo Court of Appeal Abd al-Muizz Ibrahim was reportedly behind the resignation of the jury. Judge Muhammad Mahmoud Shukri expressed his discontentment at Ibrahim's argument, and said he was ready to hold a press conference to discuss the details of the case. Shukri will also present a notification to the High Judicial Council. He refuted Ibrahim's argument and said the American suspects were charged of a crime and could be sentenced to five-year jail at least.

Experts and observers alluded strongly to a political deal behind the decision and expressed fear over the independence of judiciary.

Judge Ashraf Zahran said the incident was unprecedented in the judiciary history and strong measures are being considered to sack Abd al-Muizz Ibrahim, head of the Court of Appeal.

Men of law considered the foreign suspect's release to be an offense against the Egyptian judiciary.

Former potential presidential candidate and former head of the International for Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) said that interference in the judiciary affairs "kills democracy."

The doubted judiciary independence shed a negative light on the coming presidential elections. Many observers doubted the authenticity of the elections in the lack of independent judicial authorities. .

The Higher Commission for presidential elections announced that the elections will be held on 23 and 24 May, runoffs will be held on 16 and 17 June. The name of the elected president will be announced on June 21st. (20:00:00)

A group of 30 judges is collecting signatures on a complaint to be lodged with the justice minister: Local and world media has been reporting in the past few days about the so-called "NGO foreign funding" case and the unusual measures that surrounded it. The judicial panel overseeing the case has stepped down citing attempts to interfere in its work. On 29/2/2012, local media reported that an unknown body has issued a decision to lift a travel ban imposed on the Americans involved in the case, which is a flagrant violation of the independence of the judiciary. The judges called for opening a probe into: 1) The reasons behind the resignation of the judicial panel. 2) The reasons for lifting the travel ban imposed on the foreigners involved in the case.
