### Al-Nour Party Asks MP to Say Truth about Plastic Surgery



Al-Nour Party will not hesitate to refer its MP Anwar el-Balkimi to the Parliament’s ethics committee if the MP was proven to have lied about being attacked by armed men and that he had just undergone a plastic surgery, said party spokesman Nader Bakar.

Reports have surfaced that Balkimi, who claimed to have been mugged and assaulted by armed men, has actually undergone a nose enhancement surgery.

A cosmetic surgery hospital, named “Salma”, said that Balkimi had the surgery there and even presented documents to prove it.

The hospital said that Balkimi asked it not to reveal the news about the surgery but it could not stand idle watching the MP pretending to be a victim of an armed attack and that his nose was bandaged due to the injuries he sustained.

Balkimi denies this and said he went to the hospital to undergo a simple sinus surgery and that the attack took place afterward.

Party spokesman Bakar said medical reports showed that the MP had in fact suffered from concussion and bruises and that there was no contradiction between the two stories.

He may have undergone a plastic surgery on his nose and was then attacked on his way home, the spokesman said.

We will have no mercy with him if he was lying, Bakar warned.

## Parliament Committee Blasts at SCAF and Government over NGO Crisis



Members of the Defense and National Security Committee at the People's Assembly, lower house of parliament, vehemently condemned the Supreme Council of the Armed Forces and the government way of handling the NGO foreign funding case.

The MPs were infuriated by a decision to lift a travel ban imposed on foreigners, who were being tried before an Egyptian court over the case.

The foreign suspects even left the country on board an American military flight, which has reportedly landed in Cairo airport with the consent of the Egyptian authorities.

The MPs called for withdrawing confidence from the government and summoning the ministers of civil aviation, interior and justice and SCAF representatives to be questioned over the incident.

They also called for speeding up the enactment of a law to ensure the independence of the Egyptian judiciary.

### El-Bastawesi Starts Collecting Approvals



Potential presidential candidate Hesham El-Bastawesi started working for getting the approvals of 30 Parliamentary members, instead of getting the approval of 30,000 eligible voters.

Working to get parliamentary approval was due to the lack of time to get the approval of 30,000 votes, as presidential candidature will be opened after three days.

### Constituent Assembly Choices

كتبه - شريف-الدواخلي وعبد الرحمن أبو عوف  
 حسم حزب النور - السلفي - خياره تجاه الجمعية التأسيسية خيار تشكيل الجمعية التأسيسية للدستور بتكليف البرلمان برئاسة أعضاء الجمعية من داخل البرلمان بمرافقة، وخارجه بشكل يضمن تشكيل كل القوى السياسية والدينية شرائح المجتمع المحافظة، وقال الدكتور طلعت مبروك - عضو الهيئة العليا لهزبه النور السلفي ورئيس لجنة الاقتراحات والتشريحي لمجلس الشعب - إن حزب النور يدعم فكرة التوافق حول جمعية تأسيسية على أن يكون 70% من أعضائها نواباً بمرلمان منتخبين وشورى، وأن يمثل كل الشرائح والأكثياتيين والدستوريين ومنظمات المجتمع المدني والهيئات الخيرية الإسلامية والمسيحية من النسبة ونسب مبروك وجود أي تزمة إضائية لدى حزب النور أو لدى الإسلامية داخل البرلمان لأي قرار مهما اختلفت التوجهات، وفضلا الاقتراحات التي أوردت حول سمي الحزب لإضفاء طابعاً علمانية ودينامية يعكسها من إعداد الدستور.

تتبع مشروع الدستور الخاص بحزب النور على تغيير المادة الثانية من الدستور، بحيث تنص على أن الحكم الشريعة الإسلامية والتصورات الثابتة للشريعة في الدستور التأسيسي للوطنين، فضلاً عن تغيير نظام الحكم إلى برلماني رئاسي لكنه أقرب إلى البرلماني، واقترح الحزب أن تكون نظام الحكم في الدستور الجديد برلمانياً رئاسياً ولكنه أقرب إلى البرلماني، حيث يكون البرلمان هو المسؤول عن انتخابه والتعليق، وستكون للبرلمان بعض الصلاحيات في السياسة الخارجية، وقد يكون القائد الأعلى للقوات المسلحة، وأن يكون له دور في الاعتراض على بعض التشريعات القوانين.

في سياق متصل أصدرت الجماعة الإسلامية صوتاً حول الهيئة التأسيسية لوضع الدستور الجديد، أكدت أنه ضرورية أن تضم 70 نخباً منتخبين من أعضاء مجلسي الشعب والشورى، ولتأليف عضواً مختارين من خارج مجلسي الشعب والشورى.

واقترحت الجماعة على لسان د. صفوت عبدالقاسم - عضو مجلس شورى الجماعة الإسلامية - بأن يتضمن

الأعضاء المختارون من خارج المجلسين تعيين من اتقاء المتخلفين في النقابات المهنية، وخمسة ترشحات مجالس كليات الحقوق على مستوى الجامعات المختلفة، وأيضاً شيخ الأزهر أو من يمثله، إضافة إلى 30 من بين أعضاء جمع الجبهات الإسلامية، وخمسة أعضاء، يتم اختيارهم من بين الشكرين والفتنيتين والمصلين والشعراء والأدباء، وتابع: قدمت الجماعة مقترحاً حول انتخاب عضو واحد عن كل من تادي القضاء والمختارين من رجال القوات المسلحة والمختارين من هيئة الشرطة، وعن اتحاد العمال، وعن نقابات الطلاب.

كما اقترحت أن تضم الهيئة وليس الأعضاء طلاب مسلمين وعضواً عن اتحاد الجمعيات الأهلية، وثلاثة أعضاء ممثلين للكتيرة الأوردوكسية والكاثوليكية والبروتستانتية، وستلأ عن المجلس القومي للمرأة، وستلأ عن المجلس القومي للشباب والرياضة، وستلأ عن المجلس القومي لحقوق الإنسان وستلأ عن ممثلي الثورة.

El-Nour Salafi Party settled its choices regarding the formation of the Constituent Assembly. The party decided that the parliamentary representation in the assembly should be 50%.

El-Gama'a El-Islamiyah issued its recommendations for the assembly asserting that it should include 70 elected parliamentary members.

### Foreign Funds Case Ends by Submitting to US Pressures



Al-Tahrir received a copy from the memorandum which Senior Judge Ashraf Al-Ashmawi presented to Head of Supreme Judicial Council Senior Judge Hossam Al-Gheriani to recuse himself from the case of NGOs accused of receiving foreign funds to disrupt Egypt's stability.

Al-Ashmawi raised questions on the circumstances which surrounded the decision of Senior Judge Mohamed Shokri to step down from the case of NGOs, and the formation of a special committee that issued the decision to lift the travel ban on suspects accused of receiving foreign funds. He said Shokri felt uneasiness because the investigations made for the case were going in the wrong direction. "What happened is nothing but a response to the US pressures which clearly affected the course of investigations," said Al-Ashmawi.

James Lindsay, Senior Vice President of the US Council on Foreign Relations, said it is highly unlikely that US activists, accused in the case of NGOs, travel back to Egypt to attend their trial as they promised before they leave the country last week. In a report published by the Council on Foreign Relations, Lindsay wrote that the Egyptian authority's decision to release US activists should put an end to demands made by congressman to cut off US aids to Egypt.

Minister of Planning and International Cooperation Fayza Aboul Naga said she was surprised to hear of the court's decision to lift the travel ban on US suspects accused of



receiving foreign funds. She said she learnt about this from the newspapers like any normal citizen.

Mohamed Anwar Al-Sadat, head of the human rights committee of the People's Assembly, demanded Field Marshal Mohamed Hussein Tantawi and Prime Minister Dr. Kamal El-Ganzouri to dismiss Minister of International Cooperation Fayza Aboul Naga because she is responsible for the escalation against human rights organizations. Al-Sadat demanded an explanation from the government for the circumstances that surrounded the NGOs case, accusing Aboul Naga of fabricating the crisis through filing complaints against NGOs and mobilizing the public opinion against them.

### Ongoing Deliberations on the Formation of the Constituent Assembly



The People’s Assembly reached a form of consensus over the proposal made by the Freedom and Justice Party on the formation of the Constituent Assembly. The FJP proposed to form the assembly by selecting 40 Members of Parliament (both the People’s Assembly and the Shoura Council), 30 public figures and 30 leaders of syndicates and organizations.

Informed sources within the Muslim Brotherhood said they will nominate Dr. Yousef Al-Qaradawi, Dr. Mohamed Selim Al-Awa, Dr. Nabil Al-Arabi and Khairat Al-Shater to be members in the Constituent Assembly. Saad Al-Husseini confirmed that the FJP formed a committee to prepare lists of public figures who are nominated for the membership of the assembly.

Some politicians refused the FJP proposal to select 40% of the members of the assembly from the MPs and 60% from outside the parliament. MP Amin Eskandar demanded that only 20% of the members of the Constituent Assembly be selected from inside the parliament and 80% from all the segments of the Egyptian society. Eskandar said the consensus they were able to reach inside the parliament on the FJP proposal was due to the decision of MPs to avoid the Salafi proposal, which aimed at selecting 80% of the assembly’s members from the Members of Parliament.

Dr. Hassan Naf’aa, professor of political science, said that the constitution should reflect the aspirations of the people, not of a certain group or party. He said current Members of Parliament should realize that the constitution aims at protecting the rights of the people without marginalizing any group in the society.

### News Updates on Presidential Candidates



Amr Moussa, potential presidential candidate, held a number of electoral conferences and meetings in Damietta as a part of his presidential campaign. “The decision to release suspects accused in the case of NGOs receiving foreign funds is strange and shocking. It leaves us with only one explanation,” said Moussa.

Sheikh Hazem Salah Abo Ismail, potential presidential candidate, continued his heavy criticism against the Supreme Council of Armed Forces over the release of US suspects. “SCAF is involved in smuggling the Americans accused in the case,” said Abo Ismail. “This disaster proves that our homeland became very vulnerable and that Egypt’s sovereignty is compromised,” he added.

Hamdeen Sabbahi, a third candidate, received a number of women supporting his campaign. They included female professors, writers and political activists. They held a seminar in support of Sabbahi’s campaign.

## MP Nose to be Examined by Forensic Medicine Authority

## Parliament Divided on Withdrawing Confidence from Government



The People’s Assembly committee assigned with looking into the government policy statement that was delivered by Prime Minister Kamal el-Ganzouri was divided on floating a no-confidence vote against the government.

The Freedom and Justice Party (FJP), the majority party in parliament, is spearheading calls for withdrawing confidence from the government.

FJP representatives said the government policy statement did not live up to a post-revolutionary Egypt or to the people’s aspirations.

Meanwhile, independent MP Amr el-Shobki said he rejects, as well, the statement but called for postponing the no-confidence vote until after the presidential elections.

Shobki’s view was also adopted by the Socialist Popular Alliance Party, Al-Wafd Party, the Justice Party, the Civilization Party and Ghad El-Thawra Party.

The second largest party in parliament, Al-Nour, has not announced yet its stance regarding this issue, Shobki said.

### Tantawi: Army Committed to Transferring Power on Time

### Sabahi Praises Decision to Extradite Businessman Hussein Salem



Presidential candidate Hamdeen Sabahi praised a ruling by the Spanish judiciary to extradite Egyptian businessman Hussein Salem and his son, Khaled, to Cairo.

He also hailed the role of Egyptian community members in Spain, which led to this fruitful result.

Sabahi had visited Spain in October and met with a number of community members as part of his electoral campaign.

Salem fled Egypt after the uprising against former president Hosni Mubarak but was detained in Spain on an international arrest warrant.

The Egyptian government wants Salem extradited as one of Mubarak's closest friends to face trial in Cairo.

Salem is alleged to have profited by selling Egyptian gas to Israel below market prices. He is also involved in other corruption cases, including the seizure of millions of square meters of state-owned land and property in Sharm El-Sheikh, exploiting his good relations with the former president.

### ❖ **Al-Akhbar: Egyptian state-owned semi-official daily newspaper**

It was founded in May 1952 as a part of Akhbar El Yom.

### ❖ **Al-Gomhoria: Egyptian state-owned daily newspaper**

An influential state-owned Egyptian Arabic language daily newspaper. It was established in 1954.

### ❖ **Al-Shorouk: Egyptian daily independent newspaper**

Is a prominent Arabic newspaper published in Egypt U and several other Arabic nations It is a daily independent newspaper, covering mainly politics, militant affairs and sport.

### ❖ **Al-Masry al-Yom: Independent daily newspaper**
