Islamic Jihad Supports Abul-Fotouh

جماعة الجهاد تعلن تأييد «أبو الفتوح» وتتوقع انضمام نصف مليون سلفي إلى حزب «أبو إسماعيل»

قال نيل نعيم، مسؤول جماعة الجهاد الإسلامي، إن فريق جناح الدكتور عبد النعم أبو الفتوح تراراد بعد استبعاد حازم صلاح أبو إسماعيل، متوقفاً أن تنحصر المنافسة بين الدكتور محمد مرسي ومرشح جماعة الإخوان المسلمين والدكتور عبد النعم أبو الفتوح، لأن الأخير له شعبية بين الأوساط الإسلامية والبيروقراطية في الشارع.

ووسط حشده، في تصريحات له المسروقة اليوم، استعاد «أبو إسماعيل» بأنه كلفة على المسلمين والبيانات الدينية التي تويد تمييز الشريعة الإسلامية وجماعة لا تويد مرشح جماعة الإخوان المسلمين لأسباب تتفق بطبيعة تفكير هذه الكيانات الناشئة.

فصيححت نوحث عن مرشح في قدر وثيقة أبو إسماعيل، وحقول نفس الأفكار، وقال: «منهج» إن أغلب أصوات المسلمين التي تتراوح بين 2 و3 ملايين صوت تتوزع بين «أبو الفتوح» و«مرسي»، وإن كلفت البنية الأكبر لؤده الأول، حوقاً من سيطرة كون وتطويق واحد على أغلب مؤسسات الوطن، مشيراً إلى أن المسلمين ما زالوا يحلمون بعودة «أبو إسماعيل» وذلك إن بطوا بشكل رسمي، تكبيدهم لسردج

معين حتى تتضح الأمور، خاصة أن تأييد أبو إسماعيل، كان من قبل قطاعات عريضة من المسلمين الذين لم يتبنوا الحزب، التبرير أو يمارسوا العمل السياسي.

وتوقع حشده أن ينضم أكثر من نصف مليون سلفي إلى حزب «أبو إسماعيل» المصري، الذي يسعى لتأسيس «أبو إسماعيل» لتأسيسه، وإن يتخطى على مسيرته حزب التور السلفي، ونفى الأمر بتحقق مع الدكتور عبد النعم أبو الفتوح، في حشده في تصاحبه في الانتخابات، وتضمن لاختيارات كل الجهاديين.



After the disqualification of presidential candidate Hazem Salah Abu-Ismaïl from the presidential race, the Islamic Jihad group is seeking to support Islamist candidate Abdel-Moneim Abul-Fotouh.

The group, along with Salafists, still has hope that Abu-Ismaïl will return to the presidential race again, said group official Nabil Na'im.

But until then, most of the group's members will support Abdul-Fotouh in the race, he said.

Coptic Church Marks 40 Days since Death of Pope Shenouda III

احتفالات الكنيسة بذكرى الأربعين للبابا شنودة.. تبدأ غدا الأنبا بولا : الشرطة العسكرية والمدنية تنظم ضيوف الكاتدرائية



تحت إشراف الأنبا بولا، رئيس الكاتدرائية القبطية الأرثوذكسية، بدأ في اليوم الأول من احتفالات الكنيسة بذكرى الأربعين لرحيل البابا شنودة الثالث، وذلك في كاتدرائية القديس مرقس في الجيزة. حضر الاحتفال عدد كبير من الكهنة والقساوسة، بالإضافة إلى عدد من المسؤولين الحكوميين والعسكريين. في كلمة ألقاها، أكد الأنبا بولا على أهمية هذه الذكرى، ودعا إلى الوحدة الوطنية والتعاون بين جميع مكونات الشعب المصري. كما أشار إلى دور الكنيسة في تعزيز القيم الأخلاقية والدينية، وحث على العمل المشترك من أجل بناء مصر الحديثة.

من جانبه، أكد اللواء أحمد أبو الغيط، قائد الشرطة العسكرية والمدنية، على التزام قواته بحماية الكاتدرائية وضمان سلامة الحضور. وأضاف أن تنظيم هذه المناسبة يعكس التعاون المثمر بين الأجهزة الأمنية والكنيسة المصرية.

Presidential Elections Commission Will Legally Pursue Al-Shater



An informed source in the Presidential Elections Commission considered Al-Shater's recent statements an insult to its work as a superior judicial commission.

Deputy Supreme Guide of the Muslim Brotherhood Khairat Al-Shater had accused the commission of being biased against him as a result of talks held between the commission and the Supreme Council of Armed Forces.

“What’s wrong with holding talks with SCAF? It is the current ruling authority in the country and we have requirements that need to be fulfilled,” the source told Al-Tahrir newspaper. The source also described Al-Shater’s accusations as not true and confirmed the independence of the commission’s work.

State Commissioners Authority Refuse Dissolving National Security



The State Commissioners Authority, headed by Senior Judge Islam Al-Shahat, refused the case filed by one of the lawyers against the Head of the Supreme Council of Armed Forces Mohamed Hussein Tantawi and the Minister of Interior demanding them to confiscate all the headquarters of National Security and transform them to museums for martyrs of the revolution.

The authority explained in its verdict that the Minister of Interior's decree No. 445 for the year 2011 provided that the State Security Apparatus is dissolved and a new security apparatus titled "National Security" would be established and will maintain security and combat terrorism in accordance with the law and human rights principles.

Thus, according to the State Commissioners Authority, the National Security Apparatus is legitimate as long as it maintains freedoms and rights of the people.

Abu Ismail's Advocates Clash with Protestors



Advocates of the excluded presidential candidate Hazim Salah Abu Ismail resumed theirs sit-in for the third day, blocking Tahrir Square.

People and shops owners in Tahrir Square protested, asking Abu Ismail's advocate to open the way. Shops owners asked Abu Ismail's advocates to stop their sit-in and expel the street vendors and thugs from the square.

حذر المرشح لانتخابات رئاسة الجمهورية محمد موسى من أن هناك مخططات تستهدف إحداث اضطرابات فى مصر وسوقه، قديماً نحو علاج المشاكل التى خلفها العهد القذافي، خصوصاً أن حسن حديد بدأ يقلق موسى، أن الأمر هو التمهيدي الرئيسى الذى يواجهه البلاد، خاصة أن الإحتخابات التى تنبؤ بها أن 70% من المصريين صوتت ضد القذافي وأن عدد المصوتين سيصل إلى 100 مليون نسمة فى المستقبل القريب.

Parliament Approves Amendment to Military Judiciary Law



The Legislative Committee at the People’s Assembly, the lower house of parliament, agreed to amend an article in the military judiciary law, which gives military courts the sole authority to determine whether cases they are examining fall within their purview.

Following long deliberations, the amendment will allow military courts to rule only in cases that fall within their jurisdiction.

Egypt Cancels Gas Deal with Israel



Egyptian energy companies, citing a trade dispute, have terminated a deal to supply Israel with natural gas in a step that may further erode bilateral ties strained by a popular revolt that toppled Egypt's pro-Israeli leader last year.

An Israeli partner in the business made the step public on Sunday but an Egyptian firm said the decision to cancel the deal had been made on Thursday.

Israel, which relies on Egypt for 40 percent of its natural gas supply, worried about facing further energy cuts after a series of sabotage attacks on the pipeline running through the volatile Sinai Peninsula contributed to shortages.

Egypt was the first of two Arab countries to sign a peace treaty with Israel, in 1979, followed by Jordan in 1994.

Egypt More Dangerous Than Iran – Israeli FM



Egypt is a greater threat to Israel than Iran, according to Israeli Foreign Minister Avigdor Lieberman.

Lieberman recently sent Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu a document warning about the potential threat from Israel's southern border with Egypt.

“The Egyptian issue is much more disturbing than the Iranian problem,” Lieberman said during closed discussions on the topic, according to Ma’ariv.

According to the Hebrew daily, Lieberman believes that Egypt may violate its longstanding peace agreement with Israel and post more troops in the Sinai without permission. In the letter, he reportedly recommends that the prime minister boost the diminished southern command of the Israeli army and dispatch three or four divisions to the area in preparation for a potential mid-May regime change in Egypt.

❖ **Al-Akhbar: Egyptian state-owned semi-official daily newspaper**

It was founded in May [1952](#) as a part of [Akhbar El Yom](#).

❖ **Al-Gomhoria: Egyptian state-owned daily newspaper**

An influential state-owned [Egyptian Arabic language](#) daily [newspaper](#). It was established in 1954.

❖ **Al-Shorouk: Egyptian daily independent newspaper**

Is a prominent Arabic newspaper published in Egypt [\[1\]](#) and several other Arabic nations It is a daily independent newspaper, covering mainly politics, militant affairs and sport.

❖ **Al-Masry al-Yom: Independent daily newspaper**

On 7 June 2004, it published its first edition. The paper initially circulated primarily amongst Cairo's intellectual elite, providing objective news coverage in the belief that good news would beat sensationalist reporting found in other Egyptian print media.
