Pierre-Yves Ginet's work is dedicated to the resistance of women in the modern world. His first reports on the struggle of Tibetan nuns, from 1998 to 2001, have forced the photojournalist, in collaboration with the association Femmes ici et ailleurs (Women here and elsewhere), to widen his focus to the entire globe: between 2001 and 2012, he travelled to 22 countries to photograph women who, in their own way, are helping to write modern history. Whichever form their actions take, their initiatives are all working towards a single goal: a better future for generations to come. That exhibition presents a summary of this unique project.

Synopsis - Since 20 years, Madina Aidahis and Halima Issé, two active militants are fighting against female genital mutilation and cutting in the Afar regional state. This documentary is about their stories and struggle to sensitize people about the harmful effects of such practices. Supported by the feminist movement Femmes Solidaires, they are succeeding step by step: more than 850 girls have been spared from this centuries-old practice.
