The Gender Equality Index 2015 of the European Institute for Gender Equality (EIGE) measures the progress of gender equality in the EU and its Member States. It shows that men's over-representation in decision-making positions remains prevalent in all Member States. The unequal division of unpaid work between women and men in the private sphere remains the greatest barrier to gender equality.
