



## What do you know about Holland?

Of the 186 countries listed in the UNDP index, the Netherlands ranks fourth.





## **Dutch Higher Education**

Three degrees as part of the Bologna Process

- Bachelor's (3-4 years)
- Master's (1-2 years)
- PhD (4 years)

Research Universities (Universiteit)	science and research oriented	Bachelor Master PhD Short courses	3 years 1-2 years 4 years
Universities of Applied Sciences (Hogeschool)	oriented to practical application of knowledge	Bachelor Master Short courses	4 years 1-2 years
Institute for International Education	International programmes	Master PhD Short courses	1-2 years 4 years





## **High Quality of Education**

#### Code of Conduct

- standards for Dutch higher education institutions that offer international programmes.
- guaranteed quality of study programmes, recruitment process and counseling procedures.

### Accreditation and Quality Assurance

- CROHO (Central Register of Higher Education Programmes) → list of accredited programmes
- NVAO (Netherlands and Flanders Accreditation Organisation)



## **Tuition Fee and Living Cost**



- Bachelor €6,000-8,000 / year
- Master € 8,000-17,500 / year



- Financial support of €800-1,000 / month
- Average of € 9,000-12,000 / year
- Could be less or more, depending on lifestyle

## **Working opportunities**

- As a student
  - Maximum 10 hours per week



- 1 year visa extension to search for jobs (zoekjaar visa)
- Application is made through IND (Immigration and Naturalisation Service)
- Cost EUR 600

- Priorities for candidates with academic and career excellence, with study plan at focus areas (economics, human rights, food security, water management, judicial)
- English proficiency level of at least TOEFL IBT 79 or IELTS 6
- Academic or professional background that is related to the subject of the course
- Unconditional admission letter to the chosen study programme
- Programmes:
  - Master courses
  - Short courses
  - Customized training programmes

- Mid-career professionals (min. 3 years work experience)

- Combine funds from profit, non-profit and higher education
- Support Indonesian talents to study in the Netherlands
- Mostly partial scholarships (Foundation programmes, Bachelor, Master)
- In 2014, 22 Dutch HEIs, 2 Indonesian ministries, 1 Dutch company participating and more than 86 different scholarships provided with total value of EUR 622,725


