PRESS RELEASE

Workshop on Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza, Yogyakarta, Indonesia

The European Commission, in collaboration with the *Directorate General of Livestock and Animal Health Services* of Indonesia, is holding a training workshop in Yogyakarta, Indonesia on 3 - 6 March 2015 on Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza. The event is part of the European Commission Directorate-General for Health and Food Safety's Better Training for Safer Food (BTSF) programme.

Around 70 people from Asian, mainly ASEAN, countries are to attend. Most are national-level staff of competent veterinary authorities involved in the surveillance and control of Avian Influenza.

The training is aimed to increase participants' knowledge of European Union (EU) rules and requirements on surveillance and control of Avian Influenza. These rules are designed to protect against the introduction into and spread within the EU of this specific animal disease, which could cause severe animal and sometimes public health consequences as well as damage the economy and the poultry sector in particular.

The workshop's programme will equally include experience sharing on prevention and control of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in ASEAN countries.

By further building capacity for animal disease control in Indonesia and the ASEAN region, the EU intends to ensure that concerned exporting countries establish effective surveillance and control programmes compliant with EU legislation and the international standards of OIE (World Organisation for Animal Health).

The opening ceremony is scheduled for 9.00 a.m. on 3 March and the Workshop will be opened by the Director of the Directorate of Animal Health, Dr Pudjiatmoko, and the EC DG SANTE Minister-Counsellor on Health and Food safety, Mr. Patrick Deboyser.

Workshop programme

The first and second day of the workshop, mainly consist of presentation sessions on surveillance and control of Avian Influenza, including sharing of experiences and presentation of case studies from EU and ASEAN countries. The FAO Emergency Centre for Transboundary Animal Diseases (ECTAD) will present HPAI control activities jointly implemented with the Indonesian animal health services since 2006.

On the third day, a practical activity will be organised. Participants will visit two poultry farms and a live bird market, in order to observe and discuss the biosecurity measures designed and implemented to prevent the introduction and spread of HPAI.

The last day will be dedicated to two specific issues: the role and activity of the Reference Laboratories and the implementation of a National Compensation Fund.

This workshop is part of a series of regional workshops on Animal Health and Welfare held in Asia and the Pacific during 2013-2016, funded by the European Commission and implemented by the Consumers, Health, Agriculture and Food Executive Agency. Other subjects of workshops will include Animal Disease Control, Animal Welfare at the time of Slaughtering, Organisation of Official Veterinary Services and Contingency plans.
