'What Europe, France and Kazakhstan may learn from each other' – French Ambassador Berthonnet to discuss it with the ENU students

ASTANA – A next lecture under the initiative "A Bridge of Friendship between the EU and ENU" will be delivered by the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of France to the Republic of Kazakhstan, Jean-Charles Berthonnet on **Monday, 16 May 2011 at the Gumilyov Eurasian National University (ENU)**. Mr. Berthonnet will deliver a lecture entitled **"What Europe, France and Kazakhstan may learn from each other"**.

The ENU's faculty members, undergraduate and graduate students, Ph.D. students will have the opportunity to ask their questions and to use the provided information in their research work.

The lectures are on various aspects of life in the European Union and its Member States.
