

Specific requirements for visits for study and research purposes

The general requirements [here](#) need to be complied with before the requirements below are taken into consideration.

Please note that for any course or stay exceeding 90 days, it is compulsory to apply for a residence permit or national visa.

- Letter of acceptance from the Member State educational institution. The letter must contain the following information:
 - your personal data
 - what course you have been admitted to/what research work to be done
 - course/research duration
 - who will be responsible for supporting you financially during the time you are in the Member State
 - date and contact details
- Signed letter from your educational institution in Kenya containing your personal data, name of institution, contact details, course enrollment and number of years at institution.
- A certificate of the Member State language knowledge may be required.

Please note:

- *All submitted documents must be in English or in the language of the Member State*
- *An interview may be required at the Embassy or by phone*
- *That you may be asked to provide further information or documentary evidence in addition to the above guidelines*
