EU Ambassadors meet former Prime Minister Fuad Siniora

Today the Ambassadors of the European Union and the European Union Member States accredited to Lebanon met with former Prime Minister Fuad Siniora.

The discussion focused on EU-Lebanon relations, reforms, security and stability in the country, and the situation in Syria and the region.

The Head of the Delegation of the European Union, Ambassador Angelina Eichhorst, said after the meeting: "The Ambassadors of twenty-three EU Member States accredited to Lebanon and myself were invited to discuss collectively with former Prime Minister Fuad Siniora the situation in Lebanon, the necessary reforms for the country and the areas where the European Union could provide further support." She added: "We also discussed the situation in Syria and the region, and the steps taken by the European Union".

Twenty-three of the twenty-seven EU Member States have accredited Ambassadors to Lebanon. Sixteen Ambassadors are resident in Lebanon.
