Ambassador Angelina Eichhorst meets with Caretaker Prime Minister Najib Miqati, former Prime Minister Fuad Siniora and Sheikh Abdel Amir Kabalan

Ambassador Angelina Eichhorst, Head of the Delegation of the European Union, met today with Caretaker Prime Minister Najib Miqati, former Prime Minister and Head of the Future Parliamentary Bloc Fuad Siniora, and the Vice President of the Higher Shiite Council Sheikh Abdul Amir Kabalan. Discussions focused on the decision by the Foreign Ministers of the European Union to include Hezbollah's military wing on the list of terrorist organisations.

Ambassador Eichhorst said a terrorist attack on European soil is unacceptable, stressing that the European Union stands for justice and is against impunity. She added that dialogue continues between the European Union and all Lebanese political parties, including Hezbollah.

Ambassador Eichhorst said after her meeting with Sheikh Abdel Amir Kabalan that the decision of the European Union targeted only the military wing of Hezbollah. She stressed that dialogue and engagement with all Lebanese is particularly important for the European Union which supports them in all efforts to advance Lebanon on its path to prosperity and peace.
