EU officials visit Lebanon to discuss partnership priorities

Mr. Christian Berger, Director for the Middle East and North Africa at the European External Action Service, and Mr. Michael Koehler, Director for Neighbourhood South at the European Commission, are visiting Lebanon on 10 March.

The EU Directors will hold talks with Lebanese officials on the basis of the revised European Neighbourhood Policy (ENP). They will discuss new partnership priorities to be jointly agreed by the European Union and the Lebanese Government. The priorities will direct EU-Lebanon relations by strengthening cooperation on security, political and economic matters.

In addition, the discussions will focus on the follow-up of the London Conference on "Supporting Syria and the Region."
