perpetrators must be brought to justice. This is essential to reassure the public

that the rule of law applies in Lesotho.

The EU urges an immediate start to the process of security sector reform, as

foreseen in the 'Coalition Agreement on Stability and Reform'. This will foster

reconciliation and help in overcoming the divisions that are distracting attention

away from the many urgent reforms and development needs of the country.
