The Business Support Associations Forum kicked-off the EU4Business week in the Republic of Moldova

On Monday, 18 April, 2016 the EU4Business in the Republic of Moldova was launched with the Business Support Associations Forum. It included participation of main stakeholders, partners, EU funded projects and international organisations.

The *Business Support Associations Forum* held on the 18th of April in the Radisson Blu Leogrand Hotel kicked-off the EU4Business week in the Republic of Moldova. The Forum was organised by the European Business Association in cooperation with the European Union funded "Technical Assistance for the Implementation of the DCFTA" Project.

The Business Support Associations Forum gathered together Moldovan Government authorities, business support organisations, international donors, projects and organisations and focussed on the public-private dialogue platforms designed to lobby the interests and the needs of the small and medium sized enterprises (SMEs) in the fiscal, accounting, legal, technical and other areas, including their gradual conformity to the EU standards as part of the Association Agreement signed between the EU and Republic of Moldova.

During the Forum the international donors represented by the European Commission, the European Union Delegation to Moldova, UNDP and USAID presented their support programmes designed to contribute to the development of the SMEs and promote the public-private dialogue platforms in Moldova. Also, the Ministry of Economy expressed its support and interest to expand the public-private platforms at the regional level and encouraged the audience for a more active involvement.
