**Chisinau, 31 May, 2016** – The Delegation of the European Union to Moldova organizes the 5th edition of the summer school dedicated to the development of Moldovan Euroclubs network. The summer school will take place during 6<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> of July and plans to host 25 young people for 4 days.

The Agenda of summer school includes seminars, workshops, debates, and discussion clubs dedicated to stringent development needs of youth. While, youth will discuss about the EU programs eligible for youth from Moldova and how to develop a Euroclub, etc.
