The EU Delegation to the Republic of Moldova organised the Regional Business Forum entitled: "EU assistance for the economic development of the Republic of Moldova"

The event took place on the 22nd of December and was officially opened by the EU Ambassador in the Republic of Moldova, Pirkka Tapiola and Acting Deputy Minister of Economy, Octavian Calmîc.

The forum focused on the key aspects of the EU support provided to the Republic of Moldova, which allow the economic development of the country, offering new perspectives for the business sector and opportunities within DCFTA and the EU-Moldova Association Agreement. Moreover, the event offered the public the opportunity to discuss and share its opinion on the efficiency of the support provided by the European Union to the country.

The presentations and the discussions of the forum touched upon two topics. The first one referred to the DCFTA opportunities within the Association Agreement and the second one to the support provided by EU to the development and modernization of the Republic of Moldova.

Throughout November - December, the EU Delegation to the Republic of Moldova has organized three other Regional Forums as part of the "Europe for Moldova" communication campaign, in the framework of the EU funded project "Visibility of EU and EU assistance in the Republic of Moldova in 2015".

The forums focused on the support provided by the EU for the strengthening of the Moldovan business competitiveness on the European market based on the EU assistance and success stories in Moldova.

Representatives of the European Union Delegation and other speakers have presented the on-going and future opportunities.

The other three regional business forums were organised in Cahul, Ungheni and Comrat, with the participation of business representatives interested in learning more about EU assistance opportunities in this respect.
