Subject: Head of the EU Delegation to Pakistan meets representatives of the

Baloch Long March

5th March, 2014, Islamabad: The Head of the EU Delegation to Pakistan, Ambassador

Lars-Gunnar Wigemark, met today with representatives of the Baloch Long March

from Quetta to Islamabad, who appealed for assistance in reuniting them with their

missing family members.

Ambassador Wigemark expressed the EU's concern with the large number of enforced

disappearances and extra-judicial killings in different parts of Pakistan. The lack of

information concerning many of the disappeared in the province of Balochistan and

elsewhere is disturbing. The Supreme Court has taken notice of the issue repeatedly.

The European Union will continue to closely follow the fate of those who have

disappeared.

Ambassador Wigemark underlined that Balochistan is an integral part of Pakistan. All

citizens of Pakistan, regardless of their ethnicity, gender, or creed, are entitled to due

legal process and their fundamental human rights should be fully respected. It is the

responsibility of both the federal and provincial government, as well as the security

agencies, to ensure the safety of all Pakistani citizens – irrespective of their political

views or religious beliefs, he added.
