New European Union Ambassador arrives to Sudan



The Delegation of the European Union to Sudan announces that Federica Mogherini, the High Representative of the EU for Foreign and Security Policy and Vice-President of the European Commission appointed His Excellency Jean-Michel Dumond as the new Head of Delegation to Sudan. He arrived to Sudan on September 13 and is expected to present his credentials to the Government of Sudan in the coming days.

Ambassador - Designate Dumond was formerly the European Union Head of Delegation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. Before that, he served as the French Ambassador to Nigeria and had been posted to Germany, Italy and Romania. Ambassador Dumond was also Director for Common Foreign and Security Policy and Deputy-Director for Western Europe at the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He devoted a part of his career to the Francophonie.

The role of Ambassador Jean-Michel Dumond is to represent the European Union in Sudan, to ensure the enhancement of bilateral relations, to promote the values and interests of the European Union, notably peace, democracy, and respect for human rights through political dialogue, development cooperation and humanitarian assistance to the people of the Sudan.
