October 31, 2012 at 16:00 at the Cinema House (Union of Cinema Makers, ex. "Zebunisso" movie theatre) – Opening of the European Movie Festival

November 1, 2012 at 16.00 at the Cinema House – screening of «Lila, Lila» (Germany)


November 2, 16.00 at the Cinema House – screening of "Mother of Mine" (Finland)
