EU Ambassador met with Thai Minister of Foreign Affairs

Bangkok, 24 September 2014 - Ambassador Jesús-Miguel Sanz Escorihuela, Head of the Delegation of the European Union to Thailand, met with Minister of Foreign Affairs, General Tanasak Patimapragorn today to discuss bilateral relations.

The European Union and Thailand are bound together by strong and longstanding ties, ranging from trade, tourism, investments, culture, and people-to-people contacts.

Ambassador Sanz expressed the European Union's hopes for a peaceful, stable and prosperous future for Thailand. The European Union is convinced that this future can only be guaranteed through a genuine commitment of the Thai authorities to a truly inclusive reform process with wide participation, resulting in the establishment of full democracy in 2015.

The European Union is ready to continue engaging with Thailand during this period of reform and calls upon the Thai government to ensure respect for Thailand's international human rights obligations.
