It is my pleasure to welcome you today at the official launch of another EU-funded twinning project that will support the State Statistical Office in its further capacity building and improving compliance of statistics with EU standards.

For the European Union, providing assistance to the **statistical** offices is of high importance in the accession process. Not only that harmonization of statistics with European standards is one of the conditions that candidate countries have to fulfil in order to qualify for membership, but it is also a key element for improving the basis for decision making by state administration, businesses and citizens.

The availability of accurate, reliable and timely statistical data is crucial for obtaining a clear picture of the economy, the sociodemography of the country and for facilitating international comparisons. Statistical services capable of delivering such data are very important today, in times of rapidly changing economic conditions, when future growth and progress in all areas of the society depend on a combination of crucial well-timed decisions.

This second EU-funded twinning project provided to the State Statistical office will be jointly implemented with the Federal Statistical Office of Germany, in consortium with Statistics Denmark.
