



Erasmus Mundus scholarships for Ukrainian students

The Erasmus Mundus programme provides scholarships to individual students, researchers or scholars for studies and/or research carried out as part of an Erasmus Mundus project. If you wish to apply for an Erasmus Mundus scholarship you should apply directly to one of these projects. Two options are open:

Erasmus Mundus Masters Courses and Joint Doctorates (Action 1)

Erasmus Mundus Masters Courses and Joint Doctorates are operated by **consortia** of higher education institutions (HEIs) from the EU and elsewhere in the world. They provide **high quality integrated courses** and **joint or multiple diplomas** following study or research at two or more HEIs. They offer EU-funded **scholarships or fellowships** to students and scholars.

- **Masters students** to study in an EM Masters Course
- **Scholars** to teach or carry out research as part of an EM Masters Course
- **Doctoral candidates** to take part in an EM Joint Doctorate

Students and doctoral candidates from all over the world are eligible to apply.

138 Masters and 42 Doctorates will be selecting the candidates for scholarships for courses starting in the academic year 2014/2015. The list is available on the Erasmus Mundus website:

Erasmus Mundus Partnerships (Action 2)

Erasmus Mundus **Partnerships** bring together universities from Europe on the one hand, and from a particular region or country on the other. These are selected each year.

A wide **range of academic disciplines** is on offer for:

- **Undergraduates**
- **Masters students**
- **PhD candidates**
- **Post-doctoral research fellows**
- **Academic or administrative staff**

Mobility under Action 2 programmes

Partnerships selected under the 2013 call for proposals will be starting their preparations for the selection of students and staff from September 2013 onwards. A number of partnerships selected in 2012 will also still be open for Ukrainian students or staff to apply for mobility under Action 2, and come to study, research or teach at one of the partner universities in the EU.
