WHAT IS GATE?

GATE (knowledGe mAnagement Technology transfer and Education programme) is an Erasmus Mundus mobility project funded by the European Commission under Action 2 between 2012 and 2016.

WHO CAN APPLY

The GATE Project is aimed at students and staff who are nationals of one of the following countries:*

Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Mongolia, Myanmar, Thailand and Vietnam

In addition, the following rules apply:

- Applicants must not have resided nor have carried out their main activity (studies, work, etc.) for more than a total of 12 months over the last five years in one of the European countries at the moment of the submission of the application. This rule does not apply to target group 3 candidates.
- Applicants must not have already benefited from a scholarship for the same type of mobility under another project under the Erasmus Mundus Action 2 (EMA2) programme or Erasmus Mundus External Cooperation Window (EMECW).
- Applicants need to comply with the target group and level of mobility requirements.
- Applicants must have sufficient knowledge of the language of instruction of the Host University.

Target Group 2	Nationals of Asian partner countries who are registered at a higher education institution which is not a GATE partner but is located in one of the Asian partner countries*.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Master • Doctorate
Target Group 3	Nationals of Asian partner countries* who are in particularly vulnerable situations. This includes, for example, individuals who <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • have a refugee status or are asylum beneficiaries (international or according to the national legislation of one of the EU recipient countries); OR • have been the object of unjustified expulsion from university based on racial, ethnic, religious, or political reasons, sexual inclination or gender; OR • belong to an indigenous population targeted by a specific national policy or IDPs 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bachelor exchange • Full Master • Full PhD

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

Level of mobility	Duration	Allowance
Bachelor	1 academic year	1,000 € per month
Master	1 academic year to 22 months	1,000 € per month
Doctorate	1 academic year to 34 months	1,500 € per month
Post-doctorate	6 months	1,800 € per month
Staff	1 month	2,500 € per month

In addition, all scholars receive a full insurance coverage (travel, health, accident) and travel costs from their home country to their European host university (return ticket).
