*Invitation to contribute to the EU's annual progress report for the  
occupied Palestinian territory*

Implementation of the European Neighbourhood Policy in 2011

Every year, the European Union publishes progress reports about the most important developments in the partner countries in the European Neighbourhood. These reports review the overall **political, social, economic, cultural and environmental developments** in the respective partner countries and **weigh progress** in relation to the jointly agreed targets under the official European Neighbourhood Policy (ENP). In preparing these reports, the European External Action Service and the services of the European Commission **warmly welcome contributions received from civil society** in order to base the findings of the report on broader and more diverse inputs.

The European Union is now beginning the preparations for the sixth package of progress reports, which will **cover the whole year 2011** and which will be adopted and **published in spring 2012**. This package will be addressed to the Council of the European Union and the European Parliament. It will also be presented to the partner countries and the public at large.
