Top 3 Facts

EU Strategic Partner since July 2007 (yearly Summits, more than 30 dialogue areas active).

The EU is Brazil's biggest trading partner, accounting for more than 20% of its total trade. Brazil is the 9th largest EU exports' destination.

The EU is the biggest foreign investor in Brazil with more than 45% of the total stock of FDI in the country in 2012 (€247 bn of Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in Brazil, more than in China and India combined). Brazil is currently the 5th investor into the EU.

Did you know?

Federal Republic: 26 states + Federal District of Brasilia.

Presidential democracy (**President: Mrs. Dilma Rousseff**).

Brazil is the world's **fifth largest country** with the **fifth largest population (190 million)** and the 6th largest economy. Its GDP (\$2.5 bn) is over 50% of South America and around 75% of Mercosur's.

Brazil is the **third global agricultural exporter** and the second producer of ethanol.

Brazil established diplomatic relations with the EU on 14 June 1960.

Brazil is the 6th participant worldwide to the EU VII Framework Programme for Research and Development.
