THIRD EU-MEXICO CIVIL SOCIETY FORUM

Objective

The European Commission, in co-ordination with the Mexican Government and with the collaboration of the European Economic and Social Committee, is pleased to invite Mexican and European civil society organisations, and other organizations following the EU-Mexico relations, to the EU/Mexico civil society dialogue forum between the EU and Mexico which will take place in Brussels on 13 and 14 November 2008. The main themes will be:

- B. Cooperation
- C. Trade
- D. Institutionalisation of the Dialogue with civil society

Participation to the Forum will be open to representatives of European and Mexican civil organisations such as: non governmental organisations, trade unions, farmer organisations, employers' associations, the academic and scientific Community (universities, research centers, etc.) and other actors not included in the public sector.
