Southeast Asia is one of the most vibrant and fastest-growing regions in the world. With a population of over 630 million, the region accounts for a significant share of global trade and investment. Southeast Asia is home to some 7,000 Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) with around 12 million students. As connectivity increases and the ASEAN Community expands, national Higher Education systems are rapidly changing-and internationalisation in the sector is accelerated in the emerging ASEAN Higher Education Area.

AIMS

- Short-term mobility
- Participating countries: Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Viet Nam, including Japan and Korea
- Since 2010 to date at least 3,000 scholarships in 9 countries with 68 universities



AUN-ACTS

- University-led and funded short-term mobility with credit transfer
- Since 2010
- To date 577 scholarship in mid 2015 in the ASEAN region
- AUN member universities participate
- Managed by AUN Secretariat



SHARE

- Short-term mobility with credit transfer
- Since 2016
- To date 400 inner-ASEAN scholarships, 100 ASEAN-EU scholarships
- Initially 32 universities in 8 ASEAN countries participating
- Managed by ASEAN Secretariat, with EU support
- All less-developed CLMV countries participate
