## Do you know what the EU-ASEAN HPC initiative is all about?

Under the overall umbrella of the ongoing ASEAN-EU Science, Technology and Innovation Dialogue conducted by ASEAN Committee for Science and Technology (COSTI) and the European Commission Directorate-General for Research and Innovation (DG RTD), the EU-ASEAN High-Performance Computing (HPC) initiative was launched in 2019 with the support of the Enhanced Regional EU-ASEAN Dialogue Instrument (E-READI).

An HPC policy exchange platform composed by ASEAN and EU officials and experts has been established **'EU-ASEAN HPC Coordination Group'** for region-to-region sectoral exchanges on respective priorities, capacities, roadmaps, and to support ASEAN HPC plans.



A study was launched in March 2019 to take stock of ASEAN HPC capacities and priorities and sectoral entry points for EU-ASEAN collaboration were identified in the Life Science and Earth Science domains.

**Training sessions** were organised for a delegation of ASEAN scientists to a primary HPC centre in Europe, the **Barcelona Supercomputing Centre**.

The **EU-ASEAN HPC Initiative focuses on** human skill capital development and mobility of researchers/ scientists between ASEAN and EU research infrastructures.

Coming up, E-READI is working with the ASEAN HPC Task Force to **organise a school on HPC systems and applications in 2021 in one of the ASEAN countries**. The school will focus on systems and programming techniques and on applications, **including a track on COVID19**.
