



#TEAMEUROPE SUPPORT TO FLOOD RESPONSE IN CENTRAL VIETNAM

#TEAMEUROPE allocated **EUR 4.1 million** in **grants** for mapping, emergency relief (food assistance, distribution of non-food items and cash transfer), education, livelihoods and WASH.



IMMEDIATE RESPONSE

EUR 90,000 through EU's Copernicus Emergency Management Service to provide maps of flood risk areas at the request of the Vietnam National Centre for Hydro-Meteorological Forecasting, Vietnam Meteorological and Hydrological Administration.

EUR 500,000 from EU's Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations (ECHO) via FAO to provide multi-purpose cash transfer and hygiene promotion in Quang Binh, Quang Tri and Thua Thien Hue provinces.

EUR 800,000 from ECHO via Save the Children & World Vision to provide clean water, soap and hygiene promotion; school supplies and education kits; households kits in Quang Binh, Quang Tri and Thua Thien Hue provinces.





IMMEDIATE RESPONSE

EUR 2,000,000 from the Dutch Relief Alliance for immediate humanitarian response through supply of water, sanitation, hygiene, food, cooking stoves and cash; and multi-purpose cash transfers and vouchers to support the restart of resilience and sustainable livelihoods for vulnerable communities in the central areas.

EUR 300,000 from the Agricultural Inputs Response Capacity window of the Special Fund for Emergency and Rehabilitation Activities financed by the Government of Belgium to support the recovery of livestock production of 1,273 vulnerable smallholder farming households in Quang Binh and Quang Tri provinces.

EUR 282,300 from Irish Aid on emergency relief, livelihoods, education and cash transfers to support vulnerable households including people living with disability, school teachers, women & children of affected areas in Quang Tri & Quang Binh.

EUR 100,000 from the Czech Republic, including Czech citizen donations, on direct relief and water sanitation for flood affected communities in the central provinces.





LONG-TERM SUPPORT

The **EU** and three Member States (**France, Ireland and Italy**) have allocated a total of over **EUR 150 million** (loans and grants) for medium and long-term support for disaster preparedness & climate change adaptation.

- ✓ The **EU** supports with **EUR 10 million** the ASEAN Coordinating Centre for Humanitarian Assistance on disaster management (AHA Centre) and FAO on development of an anticipatory action approach, localized drought forecasting model, standard operational procedures and triggers for target communes in Vietnam.
- ✓ **EUR 13 million** from the Government of **Italy** during 2020-2022 to support the Vietnam Meteorology and Hydrology Administration with the equipment of automatic hydro-meteo monitoring system; set up and implementation Geo-Information System for Climate Change Vulnerability, Risk Assessment and Environment monitoring for Vietnam based on remote sensing technology.
- ✓ Blended project of **EUR 5 million** from **EU** and **EUR 123 million** from **AFD** on climate change adaptation: improvement of flood risk prevention infrastructure (e.g. drainage networks and protection dikes); upgrading service roads; developing, organizing wastewater collection and treatment; strengthening capacities of urban administrations in Ninh Binh, Thanh Hoa, Nghe An and Ha Tinh.
- ✓ **Irish Aid** plans for **EUR 1 million** to cover longer term recovery and risk reduction activities in Laos, Cambodia and Vietnam.
