Tasks

- Assess implementation of relevant legislation by the Swiss authorities (e.g. implementation of the Mass immigration initiative by the Swiss cantons);
- Analyse Swiss foreign policy and positions in international fora;
- Contribute to the daily press review;
- Provide support to the organization of the Europe Days and of other public diplomacy events in Switzerland and Liechtenstein

Profile

- Young graduate: minimum Bachelor. Master degree would be an advantage.
- Fields of study: international relations, political science, journalism and media, law, economy

Documents to be provided only by the selected candidates:

- Copy of diploma
- Language certificates
- Extract from the police records
- Passport/ID card
- Residence permit for non-Swiss applicants
- Insurance certificate (repatriation included)
- Medical certificate stating that he/she is fit for work and has no infectious diseases (a certificate written by a general practitioner is sufficient)
