by the Spokesperson of EU High Representative Catherine Ashton on the threats to the stabilisation process in Mozambique

The spokesperson of Catherine Ashton, High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy and Vice President of the Commission, issued the following statement today:

"The High Representative is concerned about recent violence and loss of life in Mozambique which have created a climate of insecurity.

She reaffirms that only a peaceful political process with a view to consolidating reconciliation in Mozambique can promote the sustainable development of the country.

The High Representative calls once again for constructive dialogue between all stakeholders as the only means to resolve political differences and reinforce democratic processes."
