The High Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy and Vice President of the Commission, issued the following statement today:

"It is with great concern that I learned of the Malaysia Airlines flight from Kuala Lumpur to Beijing which went missing early on Saturday with 227 passengers and 12 crew members on board. I would like to express my sympathy for the anguish the families of those on board must be going through at this time of uncertainty."
