by the Spokesperson on the murder of Alan Henning

"The brutal murder of British aid worker Alan Henning is another illustration of ISIL's determination to pursue its terror strategy, in breach of all universally recognized values and rights.

We send our deepest condolences to the family of Alan Henning, who had gone to Syria to help the people affected by this war.

The EU is committed to contribute to the fight against all terrorist groups that endanger regional and global stability.

Together with international and regional partners, the EU will spare no effort to ensure that an end is put to this atrocious terrorist campaign and all perpetrators are held accountable."
