- 1. The Office of the European Union to Hong Kong and Macao is planning to award the contract referred to above. The procurement documents consist in this invitation letter, the tender specifications with their annexes and the draft contract.
- 2. If you are interested in this contract, you should submit a tender in one of the official languages of the European Union.
- 3. You must submit your tender exclusively on paper, in one original and one copy. The tender must be placed inside two closed envelopes addressed as indicated below. The inner envelope should be marked as follows: "CALL FOR TENDERS NOT TO BE OPENED BY THE INTERNAL MAIL DEPARTMENT (EEAS/DELHKG/030-SER-2016)". The inner envelope must also contain two closed envelopes, one containing the technical tender and the other the financial tender. Each of these envelopes must clearly indicate the content ("Technical" and "Financial"). The time limit for submission of the tender is Friday, 10 February 2017.

You must use one of the means of submission listed below. Receipt is understood as the time at which the tenderer hands over the tender to the post office or courier service or at the reception of the Office.

- 10. This invitation to tender is in no way binding on the contracting authority. The contracting authority's contractual obligation commences only upon signature of the contract with the successful tenderer.
- 11. Up to the point of signature, the contracting authority may cancel the procurement procedure without the tenderers being entitled to claim any compensation. This decision must be substantiated and the tenderers notified.
- 12. Once the contracting authority has opened the tender, it becomes its property and it shall be treated confidentially.
- 13. You will be informed of the outcome of this procurement procedure by e-mail only. It is your responsibility to provide a valid e-mail address together with your contact details in your tender and to check this e-mail address regularly.
- 14. If processing your reply to the invitation to tender involves the recording and processing of personal data (such as your name, address and CV), such data will be processed pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 45/2001 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the Community institutions and bodies and on the free movement of such data. Unless indicated otherwise, your replies to the questions and any personal data requested are required to evaluate your tender in accordance with the specifications of the invitation to tender and will be processed solely for that purpose by the Head of EU Office to Hong Kong and Macao.
