- 2) To enhance the quality of elementary education by reinforcing and retooling the system for the continuous professional development of teachers
- 3) To improve the governance and management within the sector by improving the provincial data management, monitoring and planning systems

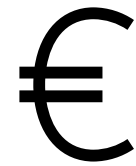



Multi Donors Trust Fund (MDTF II)



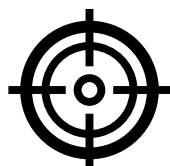


