In February, the European Commission unveiled a White Paper on Artificial Intelligence (AI) which aims to foster a European ecosystem of **excellence** and **trust** in AI. The White Paper proposes measures that will streamline research, foster collaboration between Member States, and increase investment into AI development & deployment and suggests policy options for a future EU regulatory framework which are subject to an ongoing public consultation.
