Call for Contributions (EUAM CAR)

List of recommended equipment

The civilians and police officers deployed by EU Member States and Contributing Third States to EUAM CAR should - for c and d: must - have the following clothing and equipment:

- **a.** *National Police Uniform and Field Working Police Uniform* (The uniform should clearly indicate a difference between police and military forces.
- **b.** *Shoes* (service uniform)
- **c.** <u>*Protective helmet*</u> (CEN Level III or national equivalent: CEN prEN ISO 14876-2 (equal to NIJ level IIIA, norm NIJ 0101.06 protection minimum requirement).
- **d.** <u>Armoured vest</u> (NIJ Level IV or national equivalent (by means of 2 hard-armoured plate inserts (250x300) at front and back) minimum requirement).
- **e.** Police/Military Officers shall be fitted with armament (a 9 mm duty side arm with 100 rounds of ammunition, and a long weapon together with five loaded magazines for those who have been qualified and trained)
- f. Field boots (desert)
- g. Sleeping bag
- h. Combination knife
- i. Mosquito-dome
- j. Disposable latex gloves
- k. Flashlight
- **I.** Whistle
- m. Desert goggles
- **n.** Sunglasses
- **o.** Sun lotion
- p. <u>Non-alcoholic</u> antibacterial hand wash
- q. Mosquito repellent
- **r.** Eye wash solution
- s. Rehydration packs
- t. Passport
- u. Identity cards and driver's license
- v. Medical Record card
- w. Wallet or purse with money and credit cards
- *x. Mobile phone and charger*
- y. Hard Water bottle
- z. A small quantity of high energy food
- aa. A jacket (dependent on weather)
- bb. Critical personal documents, such as original prescription for medicine

cc. Temporary dental filling (filling material for temporary restoration of dental cavities)
dd. Medical and trauma pack
