2021 ASSISTANCE MEASURE

- Decided on 2 December 2021: reference amount of €7 million
- · Support to military medical, explosive ordnance disposal (EOD) capacities
- Implemented by: Central Project Management Agency (CPMA), Lithuania.



2022 ASSISTANCE MEASURE

- Decided on 30 June 2022: reference amount of €40 million
- Support to logistics, mobility, command and control, cyber defence, unmanned aerial reconnaissance, and tactical communications
- Implemented by: e-Governance Academy for cyber, Estonian Centre for Defence Investment (ECDI) for all other capacities, Estonia.



2023 ASSISTANCE MEASURE

- Decided on 4 May 2023: reference amount of €40 million
- Support to air surveillance, mobility, logistics, command and control, cyber defence.
- Implemented by: e-Governance Academy for cyber, ECDI for other components, Estonia.
