Supporting Colombia's plan to increase connectivity to 85% of the population by 2026 via 5 pillars:

1. Connectivity for 'Paz Total':

- technical cooperation to facilitate private investment and the deployment of new technologies for connectivity
- investment facilitation through the Global Gateway Investment Agenda (GGIA)
- 3 pilot connectivity projects in 3 municipalities to facilitate local communities' access to various services and opportunities

2. Cybersecurity:

- creation of a National Cybersecurity Agency and offer specific training in the field of cybersecurity and cyber capacity-building
- strengthening Colombia's adherence to fight against cybercrime
- 3. Creation of a space and cybersecurity agency to facilitate the systematic use of satellite data (e.g. to improve the management of natural resources and face challenges such as natural disasters etc.)

4. Research and Data Economy:

- BELLA cable extension
- facilitating business digital transformation with Chamber of Commerce of Bogotá
- Digital Accelerator
- 5. Contributing to the spread of digital literacy and further exploration of the phenomenon of gender violence in the digital environment
